A MESSAGE FROM THE CHAIRMAN

The 2018 season is nearly upon us. Rod Hill and George Charalabidis have been working hard recruiting since last year, players and coaches have been at it since early November and everyone is keen to get started. Our new Football Director Chris Brown has been fantastic in his commitment to the club. Chris has overseen the renovation of the change rooms, establishment of the new gym (funded entirely by senior players, coaches and volunteer workers), running the football department and many other things beyond the scope of his job description.

We will be having a season launch during the day on Saturday April 7th at the club, which will be a great opportunity for members and supporters to meet some of the new players, chat to some of our loyal regular players and welcome back some old favourites (look for more details on facebook or team app in the coming weeks). Our playing group look in great shape and we are excited about the season ahead under A grade coach Jarrad Parker and assistants Ryan Sampson and Iszac Thompson. Sam Heeps has been appointed as the new B grade coach and it is a pleasure to welcome Sam to the Sharks. Sam is the son of a Henley gun, Paul Heeps. Paul was a member of the 1973 and 1983 premiership teams and won a Hone medal which is the Brownlow of the amateur league. I expect we will see Paul out supporting his son after returning from Queensland this year. Browny will coach the C grade again, we will have a new C7 coach, the over 35's are raring to go again, Slippery Nicol is coaching the Under 18 boys and Karl Dobner is coaching the new Under 18 girls team. We are excited about the prospect of building to a senior women's team next year to create a pathway for our junior girls.

The Junior program has been extremely successful for a long time and Henley is benefiting throughout the senior ranks. We obviously want players to reach their maximum potential and we celebrate our juniors reaching AFL and SANFL ranks, but we are privileged to have many players progress through junior ranks direct into seniors and we also welcome players returning to Henley at any time. We currently have 281 boys registered to play in 14 boys teams, 133 girls registered to play in 6 girls teams, Auskick will run again (85 last year) and we will have 3 under 7 minis teams (36 players last year). There will be around 550 juniors involved in the junior programs at The Sharks this year. Thank you to John Muir, the Football Director of the juniors, the junior committee, coaches and volunteers who are working really hard to develop such a large group of players and manage day to day running of the juniors. I urge parents to get involved with the club, by volunteering, supporting, making friends and enjoying your time at the Henley Football Club. I have had the pleasure of meeting good people and making many great friendships through my time at Henley as a player and parent.

I am pleased to announce that we have had tremendous support from local business and supporters who sponsor the club. In 2018 we have already had commitment from The Lockleys Hotel in their 4th year as a major sponsor. PRE SEASON REPORT BY JARRAD PARKER

A Grade Senior Coach 2018

After a bit of uncertainty around the club at the end of 2017 I was excited to accept the opportunity to be senior coach of the Henley Football Club. Building from the excellent platform that Jarrad Wright and Brent Reilly had put in place, I was able to hit the ground running and set out my vision for the club.

Since I took over at the end of November, the numbers on the track have been exceptional, particularly in the last 4 weeks where we haven't had less than 50 players on the track on any given weeknight. We have in excess of 20 players at the club that weren't part of the senior group last year which has injected a lot of enthusiasm around the place. Most pleasing is the large number of younger players on the track which shows the club is in a good position for the future. I hope to be able to introduce all of the new players to you at our season launch prior to Round 1.

As well as the new players, we also have some new coaches in the B Grade and U18's. As previously announced Sam Heeps has taken on the role of B Grade coach and Kyle Nicol has put his hand up to take on the U18's role. They have both already shown they have qualities and skills that will complement the existing coaching group.

My aim with pre-season training this year has been to add some variety, to provide players with new challenges whilst still doing the inevitable running that preseason requires. A couple of the highlights of the pre-season so far have been the group run up Mt Lofty Summit. Some of the players may suggest that my timing was a bit off as at the time they were doing some renovations which caused us to run an extra 1.4km (each way) than the normal track requires. Coupled with the fact that it was about 33 degrees that night and you've got yourself a pretty solid session. These points aside we had 32 players make the journey there and along with 4 of the coaches everyone made it to the summit. By the time we made it back to the bottom we had run 10.5km and I know I certainly felt every one of them.

The other highlight was a training day we held on the 24th February. We had 48 players attend who were divided into 4 teams. The teams were given instructions and maps and had to navigate their way to locations around West Lakes where different challenges waited for them. The challenges included a swim, building and using a raft, blindfolded tasks, football skills and some mental exercises. But the highlight for all of the teams was being put through their paces at 'Base Camp'. Once the players had pushed themselves to exhaustion in the gym and with a truck push Luke, one of the trainers at Base Camp, challenged the players mentally to work together as a team to complete tasks on the obstacle course. Again, all players really put in and a lot was taken out of the day by players and coaches alike. These days can't run smoothly without the assistance of volunteers; thanks to all the coaches, Renee for being our insurance policy which we fortunately didn't need and Vanessa and Vicki for supply the boys with lunch.

On top of the two sessions during the week, Brett Ebert has been running an optional session on Saturday mornings during the preseason. The aim of this session has been different to the weekday, whereby Brett has concentrated on building leg and core strength amongst the group. I think the regulars of this session will see the added benefits during the year.

All in all, I have been really happy with the effort and commitment shown by the whole senior group. We are coming up to our trial games which everyone involved is looking forward to. There certainly is a lot of enthusiasm amongst the group and I think all augurs well for Henley to be competitive in all senior grades this year.
