## **MATCH REPORT - JARRAD PARKER**

A Grade Senior Coach 2019

Round 7 saw us enter a three game stretch against the top 3 teams in the competition. First up was PAOC and we knew that their strengths were their organisation and ball use. We had three new players to the side for their first A grade game this week in Henley juniors Josh Hornibrook and Nick Thunig and new player to the club Ricky O'Loughlin.

In the first quarter we felt as though we had as much of the football as PAOC but the difference was their cleanliness. We were dominating around the stoppages again as Jack Enright and Lachlan Ryan were getting a lot of the football but our delivery into our forward lines was either scrappy or predictable. Our only major for the quarter coming from a Jack Enright crumb and goal. Conversely PAOC were making the most of their opportunities and went into the break with a handy 3 goal lead.

The rain came in the second quarter and while the oval was holding up well the ball became greasy. We again had as much if not more of the football than PAOC but one thing we can take away from them this week was their patience with the football when required, controlling the tempo of the game when they possessed it. Brodie Kitto again thrived in the wet conditions and through goals to Travis Lane and Nathan Bowles we outscored them and went into the half 2 goals down.

The game opened up a bit in the third quarter as it became very much end to end football. Nathan Bowles and Corey Gray were maintaining their recent good form and Liam Martin continued to show his work rate and effort on the wing. But our backs were under siege as PAOC seemed to find gaps in our defence too often, and were getting multiple opportunities at goal even though Charlie Morrison was positioning himself well and taking his usual quota of intercept marks. Our problem was the attacking side of our game as we were being too predictable with our movement, which was playing right into the hands of the PAOC defence and we were getting caught out on the rebound. When we did move the ball quickly and changed the angle of play we looked dangerous which occurred when we found Ben Lodge running into an open goal square.

In the last quarter the boys worked hard right to the very end but our footy was scrappy and they were a lot cleaner than us. Nick Thunig showed that he wasn't overawed by his first A grade game and Ned Heath was again competing hard, getting his reward from PAOC as they kicked the ball the wrong way straight too him resulting in a goal.

As a group we acknowledge the areas of our game we need to work on, but I don't think we are that far off and hopefully in time that bit of improvement will start showing through.

His dedication, determination and willingness to learn has obviously allowed him to achieve his goals – We wish him The Best of Luck in the coming Years!




#### **VOLUNTEERS AT WORK**


