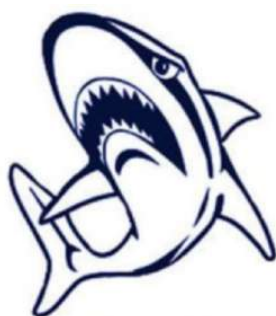

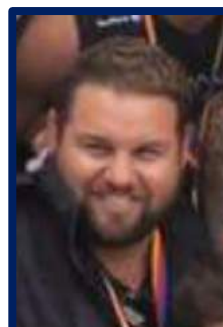

# **MATCH REPORT - JARRAD PARKER**

**A Grade Senior Coach 2019**

While no team wants to be 0-4 to start a season, we have been confident that we have improved with each game and there could be no questioning the players will for the contest. Adelaide Uni had been playing some good football so we knew that it was going to be a tight game.

We started the first quarter well, we had a real emphasis on our midfield this week and they started well with Nathan Bowles getting us first touch. We had our opportunities early but couldn't capitalise, then late in the quarter we found ourselves stuck in our defensive 50. We were being predictable without ball movement which was causing the ball to rebound quickly, we gave up 4 first quarter goals and could only manage 1 ourselves but at the break the game didn't feel as though it was completely out of our hands.

I felt we started getting on top in the second quarter and this started in the midfield, we were winning the stoppages as Corey Gray, Brad Geddes and Jack Enright got in Sync with Nathan Bowles. Again our skill errors were costing us but we had a lot more of the football for the quarter and were creating plenty of opportunities. Harris Jessen was proving a handful for his opponent early in the quarter and he kicked a nice set shot for the quarter followed by Joel Harvey-Friel's first A grade goal. Harry Sibley and Lachy Ryan were giving us plenty of run from half back and the wing and at half time we had got ourselves back into the game and had some confidence in how we were playing.

The third quarter was a tight contest, both teams were getting their opportunities, the difference was that Adelaide Uni were converting theirs. In the backlines Charlie Morrison was clean at ground level and Angus Coxon was enjoying his move back to the backlines and was standing strong in the contest. We were moving the ball well but we kicked 0.7 for the quarter which you could see was deflating to the group.

One area I think the team is developing is their resilience to the circumstances of the game. While this is still a work in progress the players knew they were playing well and if they maintained that, the goals would inevitably come. The weather had set in but this brought the best out of some players. Damien Cardone had been brought into the team for his ball use and composure and he showed this in the last. The wetter it got the better Brodie Kitto and Joel Harvey-Friel got, their ability to be clean with the ball in those conditions stood out. Brodie was giving us great link up through the middle of the ground and Joel was dangerous up forward. Firstly showing a bit of swagger to run away from two players, have a bounce in the wet conditions and kick truly then link up with Brodie and kick a good snap in the goal square that would put the result in our favour. (Then gave a bit extra with his celebration!)

Adelaide Uni had all of the ball in the last 3 minutes but some dour defending kept the result in our favour. It certainly wasn't a pretty game of football but I was just pleased for the players that they got some reward for the effort they have been putting in. Sometimes a win like that is all that is needed to jumpstart your season and we hope that is the case this week as we get another opportunity at home against last years premiers, Tea Tree Gully.

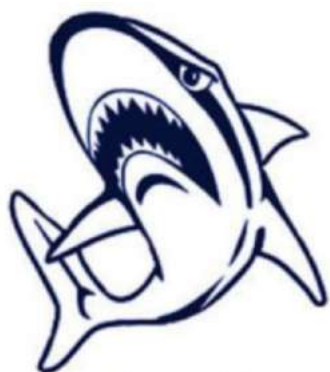
