

MATCH REPORT - JARRAD PARKER

A Grade Senior Coach 2019

Round 10

Vs St Peters: 9.13-67 - 10.9-69

Into Round 2 and while the results haven't panned out as we would have hoped so far, we still believe our best is good enough to mix it with all teams we just need to show some more consistency throughout games. We had 6 forced changes this week which is just becoming par for the course this year but we welcomed back some senior players amongst that.

I thought we controlled the ball reasonably well for the first half of the first quarter, and while St Peters were on top of us around the stoppages, we were spreading really well and using the ball better than we have been. Cody Egel was working hard around the feet of the forwards and was rewarded with our first goal and after some good ball use into the forward lines Jackson Smith marked and goaled to get our second. Towards the end of the quarter St Peters got some repeat shots on goal but almost all were under good pressure from our defenders resulting in minor scores.

We were getting a lot of the football in the second quarter but St Peters are very good at zoning off and we were making poor decisions and picking them out. As the quarter wore on though our continued pressure, which was as good as it has been, was wearing them down. In the backlines our 3 talls Ned Heath, Jake Hyland and Charlie Morrison were working together well to nullify the influence of their big forwards and through the middle the usual suspects of Geddes, Enright, Gray and Ryan were getting their hands on the ball. Some clean coast to coast football saw a goal to Nathan Bowles which was followed by two goals to Jack Hambly and one to Geddes. We held St Peters to one goal and went into half time with a 20 point lead.

While St Peters kicked the first goal early, I thought we started the third quarter reasonably well around the ground and created 3 good opportunities which we couldn't convert. About halfway through the quarter St Peters started to really dominate around stoppages and were able to feed their big forwards. They kicked 3 goals in reasonably quick succession and you could see our players go back into their shell. We started playing into their hands and lost our willingness to take the game on which only made things worse and created more chances for them. We had lost our control of the game and were now 11 points down.

At the start of the last quarter the boys responded to being challenged and played with confidence, possessing the football through the back half and moving the ball through the middle of the ground. We kicked the first two goals of the quarter through Ben Lodge and Corey Gray and there was a determination within the group. But St Peters are a top 5 side for a reason and hit back with the next two goals, the last after catching us napping at a defensive 50 stoppage. There was 9 mins left in the game and we were 11 points down, a position we have been in before and one that has seen us drop out heads. But with 5 minutes to go Liam Martin found Ben Lodge in space who kicked a cracker of a goal on his left and that belief came back again. Back to the middle and within a minute we sent another high ball to the goal line where Jackson Smith took the most important contested mark of his short career then converted the chance. It wasn't a case of just hanging on from there either, the ball remained in our forward lines for the rest of the game and there isn't much of a better sight than the happiness on the boys faces as that siren sounded.

Our leaders Ned Heath, Brad Geddes and Corey Gray showed the way, particularly in the last quarter, Jackson Smith continues to improve and stood up at pivotal moments and Lachy Ryan's composure again was a feature. Outside of this it was the young brigade of Cody Egel, Cain Smith, Kyle Nicol, Josh James and Liam Martin that played really important roles all day. An enjoyable day and hopefully one that will lead to more success.
