**Treating the Anxious Dental Patient – Sedation in Dentistry**

Dr. Naftalin is a dentist anesthesiologist that provides hospital-quality anesthesia and sedation services in dental offices through his mobile anesthesiology practice. He earned his DDS degree from the USC School of Dentistry and completed a general practice residency at the Veteran's Administration in West Los Angeles. He then completed the UCLA Dental Anesthesia residency. Dr. Naftalin maintains a part-time teaching position at the UCLA School of Dentistry, in both the dental anesthesia and pediatric dental departments.

He is currently the vice president of the American Society of Dentist Anesthesiologists. He serves on the board of the California Society of Dentist Anesthesiologists, and the California Dental Society of Anesthesia. He is the past president of the American Dental Board of Anesthesiology. He is the past president and former editor for the Southern California Society of Dentistry for Children.

Dr. Naftalin is dedicated to a program that provides anesthesia for dental patients with special needs in Nicaragua. Without this program these patients would have no access to dental care.

Dr. Naftalin has been interested in what happens to our patients and their brains during and after the anesthesia care.

**Course Description:**

Dr. Naftalin will review the nuts and bolts of sedation, from guideline and regulations, to how to prepare your patients preoperatively for sedation. He will review how to keep your patients safe under sedation, and review what is the appropriate monitoring that is required. From pre-op to discharge, Dr. Naftalin will discuss some of the hottest topics related to sedation and anesthesia.
