### What to pack

One small suitcase/duffel bag to be stored under the motor coaches. (Coaches will be full, and instruments will also be stored in the undercarriage, so pack conservatively.) Remember toiletries, phone charger (and maybe a battery pack), and clothing for in the stadium, at the mall, on the bus, and in rehearsal. Include pajamas/sleepwear.

One small backpack or carryon bag to bring on the coaches. We recommend that you bring homework, if appropriate.

Pack a sack lunch for Friday, bring bus snacks if desired, and bring money for dinner on Friday (mall food court) and Saturday (stadium concessions). Breakfast on both days is provided at the hotel, and a Subway lunch is included on Saturday.

Remember to pack your show shirt, boxer/compression shorts, and black socks to be worn under your uniform. Your gloves and shoes should travel to the show on the uniform racks. Bring anything else that you need for rehearsal and the show. Most instruments will travel under the coaches.

#### **Additional Info**

Be sure that you have signed up for the BAND app and have your notifications turned on!

Parents who are picking up their student from the stadium on Saturday night must provide a written note to the bus chaperone (preferred) or an email to the band directors (not preferred). Text messages will not be accepted. For the sake of student safety, the parent and student must see the bus chaperone or a band director to check out before leaving the stadium. On this trip, the best time to do this is after the finals performance (if selected) or at the coaches after the announcement of finalists (if not selected.) If a parent is not present to pick up their student at the time of departure, the band's departure will not be delayed, and the student will remain with the band for their own safety. Students are required to stay in the assigned area listed on this itinerary. Students may not leave the mall, stadium, etc.
