NOTICE OF RACE

NB: The notation '[DP]' in a rule in the Notice of Race means that the penalty for a breach of that rule may, at the discretion of the protest committee, be less than disqualification.

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part 1 shall apply.
- 1.3 The 12ft skiff rules as defined in the Interdominion 12ft Sailing Championship Rules, as accepted on 12 January 2019 will apply.
- 1.4 The sailing instructions will consist of the instructions in RRS Appendix S, Standard Sailing Instructions, and supplementary sailing instructions that will be on the official notice board located at the event headquarters in the vicinity of Worser Bay. A draft copy of Supplementary Sailing Instructions may be emailed to participants on acceptance of entry. These will also be available on the WBBC website.
- 1.5 Appendix T, Arbitration, will apply.

2 ADVERTISING

Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organising authority. If this rule is broken, World Sailing Regulation 20.9.2 applies.[DP]

A boat may carry advertising on her hull and sails with no restriction.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the 12ft Skiff Class that comply with the 12ft Skiff Class Rules.
Boats must display their bow number as registered in Australia and New Zealand.
- 3.2 R Class Skiffs are eligible to race, however are not eligible for any 12ft Skiff trophies.
- 3.3 Eligible boats may enter by logging on to the Worser Bay Boating Club website www.wbbc.org.nz and completing the on-line entry form and paying the entry fee on-line. The completed Entry Form and Payment is to be received by midnight Sunday 16th February 2020.

4 FEES

4.1 Required fees are as follows:

<i>* Note. Any Australian team sailor who has not sailed in Interdominion Championships held in New Zealand previously shall have their entry fee waived. Eg. If entered boat has one new sailor, entry fee is \$150. If two new sailors, entry is free.</i>	

5 SCHEDULE

5.1 Registration: Sunday 23rd February 08:30-9:00 followed by sailors briefing and welcome..

The race officer may schedule additional racing on any day, or change the scheduled start time (in consultation with team captains). Racing may also be scheduled on Thursday 27 th Feb if required.			

5.3 On the last scheduled day of racing no warning signal will be made after 14:30 hrs. A Presentation Dinner will be held on the evening of 29th Feb.

6 MEASUREMENT

6.1 All boats shall comply with the 12ft skiff class rules as agreed in Addendum A of the Interdominion 12ft sailing Championship Rules. Random measurement

checks may be carried out at any time during the regatta at the discretion of the race committee.

6.2 Boats may also be checked for safety compliance.

6.3 A boat shall comply with RRS 78.1 throughout the contest and may be checked at any time during the event.

7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available at registration.

8 VENUE

8.1 Attachment A shows the location of the regatta venue.

8.2 Attachment B shows the approximate location of the racing areas.

9 THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed may include laid windward-leeward and harbour courses.

10 SCORING

10.1 Five races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

10.2 When fewer than 6 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

10.3 When 6 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

10.4 When 8 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

11 HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS

All boats must launch and retrieve from the Worser Bay Beach south of the club house building site and must remain outside of any swim patrol flag area. [DP]

Beach trolleys should be in a compact area and must not be left between any swim flags on the beach while competitors are afloat. [DP]

Overnight boat storage will be on the grass area near the pavilion south of the club house. [DP]

12 RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones. [DP]

13 PRIZES

Prizes will be given as follows:

- Nimble Trophy for best placed rookie
- Alf Fleet Trophy for crew of Race 1 winner
- Jack Winning handicap trophy

14 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be responsible for their own insurance. As a minimum a current 3rd party policy should be held.

15 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

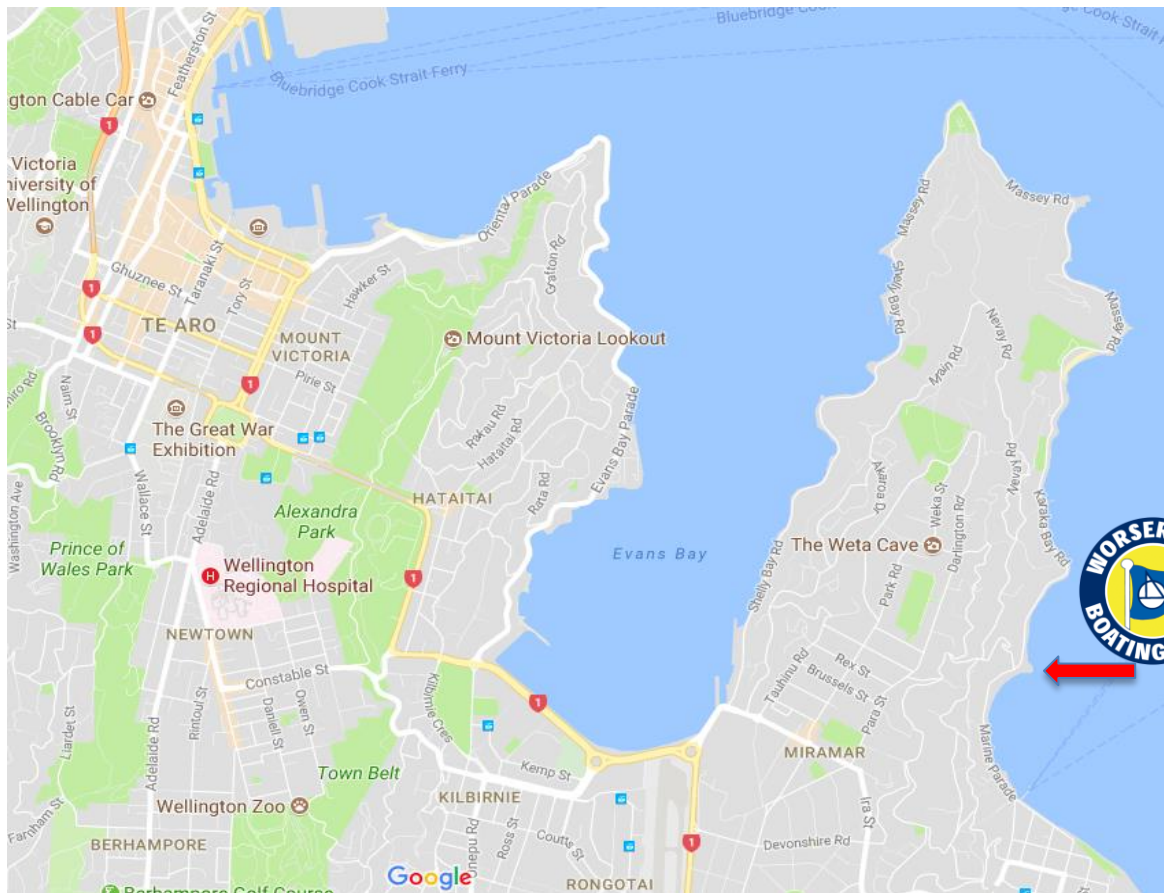
