 Spreading Ground Covers



FEATURES:

- Ornamental, fleshy foliage for year round interest.
- Forms a cushion-like mound making a highly textural ground cover.
- Low maintenance and easy to grow.
- Dry tolerant once established.

SUGGESTED USES:

- Ground cover or edging for paths/ driveways.
- Rockeries, gravel or dry garden designs.
- Small gardens or spaces.
- Containers and general garden use.

CULTURAL CARE

Ensure soil is well draining and location is sunny. Once established, water sparingly. No other maintenance is generally required although if grown in containers an addition of a slow release fertiliser during spring would be beneficial.
