Do costumes tell us who the  
character is or what role they play in  
the overarching narrative?

#### Lighting

What kind of lighting is used and  
with what emotional or connotative  
effect?

Who is placed in shadow?

Who is given light?

#### Composition

What sort of shot distance is used?

Is the subject on the left or right side  
of the frame?

What connotations does this  
positioning create for the audience?

Is a closed or open frame used?

Is tilt applied?

#### Post production/anchorage

What colours are  
foregrounded and with what  
connotative effect?

Is colour taken out of the shot?

What elements, if any, anchor the  
meanings constructed by set text  
imagery?
