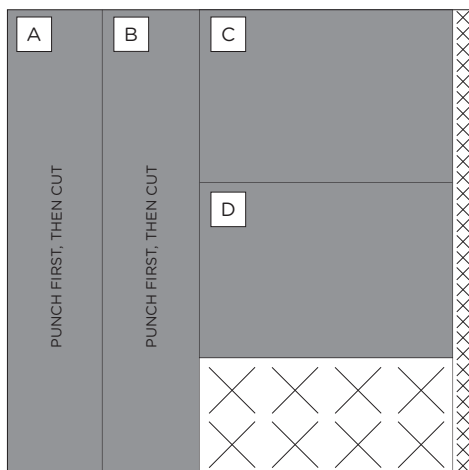

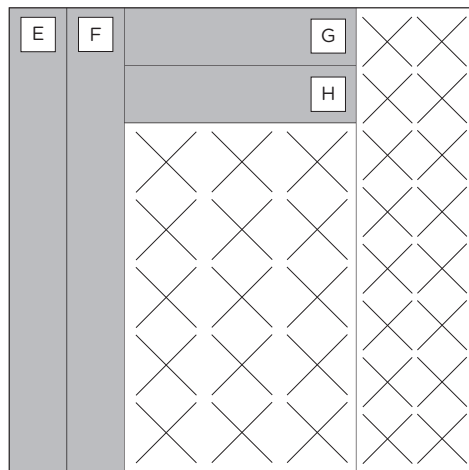
CUTTING GUIDE

Make the following cuts on Cardstock and Designer Paper.

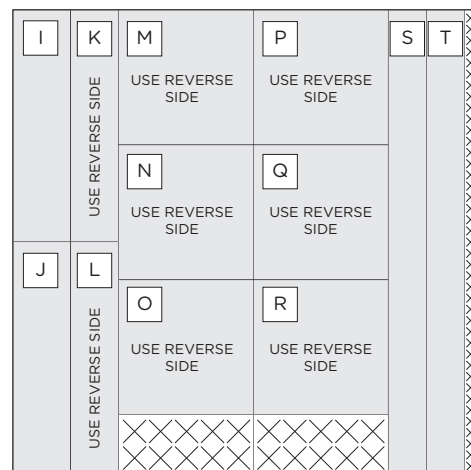
1 Cardstock



2 Designer Paper #1



3 Designer Paper #2



MEASUREMENTS:

A - Border	E - 1-1/2" x 12"	I - 1-1/2" x 6"	O - 3-1/2" x 3-1/2"
B - Border	F - 1-1/2" x 12"	J - 1-1/2" x 6"	P - 3-1/2" x 3-1/2"
C - 6-1/2" x 4-1/2"	G - 6" x 1-1/2"	K - 1-1/4" x 6"	Q - 3-1/2" x 3-1/2"

INSTRUCTIONS

- Use the two tone-on-tone papers as the base for this spread.
- Using the Filmstrip Border Maker Cartridge in the Original Border Maker System, punch along one edge of the Black Cardstock. Cut to measure 2-1/2" x 12". Repeat this step, so that you have two Filmstrip Borders.
- Cut the remainder of the Black Cardstock following the cutting guide.

- Cut the pieces from Designer Paper #1 and #2 according to the cutting guide.
- Adhere pieces E and F behind the film strip openings.
- Using a scissors, gently fold pieces G, H, I, J, K and L in half at one end, then cut at an angle to create the "v".
- Adhere all the pieces to the spread following the sketch.

OPTIONAL ADD-ONS:

- Adhere stickers to the spread, using Foam Squares on some for added dimension.
