Sister Kathleen Hughes, rscj



Sister Hughes, rscj, is a sacramental theologian, teacher, speaker and writer and has held many positions of distinction. She was the first woman to receive a doctorate in liturgical studies from the University of Notre Dame. She is the author of ten books and several hundred articles and reviews, demonstrating a broad range of interest in worship, sacraments, preaching, language and feminism.

Sister Hughes, rscj, currently oversees the preparations to celebrate the 200th anniversary of Saint Philippine Duchesne’s arrival in the New World in 1818, an anniversary which also marks the beginning of the Society’s internationality.
