Bargaining Update

The CANSA Bargaining Team met with Nav Canada's representatives for bargaining in Montreal on July 22 – 23, 2019.

A high-level discussion by both parties on all monetary and non-monetary issues was completed during the two days with several presentations by Nav Canada and ended with a Q & A period.

The next round of bargaining is scheduled in Ottawa on Oct 30, 31 and Nov 1, where we will be working on specific proposals. The reason for the later date in October is to enable CANSA to run our early fall elections to re-establish our Bargaining Team and to determine the impact of the Fatigue Management on the CANSA membership as it may impact negotiations.

Your Bargaining Team greatly appreciates your patience as we overcome the challenges ahead and bring to you the best possible agreement for ratification.
