Nestled in the Rincon Mountains, this spot is full of cacti, wildflowers and creosote bushes and has a magical sunset. For this location, you will follow me in your car around the 10 mile park loop, stopping at multiple locations.

Head east on Broadway Blvd. and take a right on Houghton Rd. After 2 miles, turn left onto Old Spanish Trail. In 3 miles, the entrance to the park will be on the left. We will meet in front of the visitor's center and drive the loop together.
