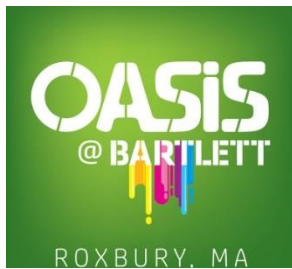




INFORMATION FOR ROXBURY'S GOT TALENT PARTICIPANTS

- 1) Who is eligible?** Any resident of Roxbury of any age or anyone who has a strong tie to Roxbury through past residency/work in the community, etc.
- 2) What kind of talent must one have?** We are looking for musicians, singers, dancers, spoken word, poets, solos, duos, trios or small groups.
- 3) When is the audition?** Tuesday, September 10, 2019 at 6 pm at the Bartlett Station Community Room, Second Floor, 2565 Washington Street, Roxbury.
- 4) What is required at the audition?** The audition selection must be no shorter than 3 minutes and no longer than 5 minutes. If you are selected as a finalist, you must use the same selection on the Festival Stage as you perform at the audition.
- 5) What will be provided at the audition?** Please bring your CD and a CD player with you to audition. If you need a piano for the Festival Stage, you will have to provide the Keyboard. We will have speakers and microphones, as well as music stands. We will also be able to play a CD to accompany you on the Festival Stage.
- 6) What do you need to wear at the audition?** Please dress for the audition in either the same outfit you plan to wear on stage or something very similar. If you require a costume, there are rest rooms where you can change into your costume for the audition.
- 7) Are there any limitations on the performance?** Yes. The material selected must be acceptable for family audience. No music or lyrics or readings that contains foul language.
- 8) When will we be notified if we are in the finals?** Everyone will be notified by the 13th of September. **DO NOT AUDITION IF YOU CANNOT ATTEND THE FESTIVAL AND PERFORM ON THE STAGE BETWEEN 3:15 PM AND 5:00 PM ON SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 28, 2019 AT 2565 WASHINGTON STREET IN ROXBURY.**
- 9) in addition to five finalists, the panel may select two alternates, in case anyone drops out or in case the finalists use less than the maximum time allotted.**
- 10) What are the prizes?** There are three prizes: 3rd place \$100; 2nd place \$250 and 1st place \$500.
- 11) All finalists must sign a release form that allows Nuestra Comunidad to photograph and videotape the finalists for use in marketing materials. Any finalist under the age of 18 must get a parent signature in order to compete and win a prize. All prizes will be issued in the form of a check, made payable to the winner, and in the case of a group, in the name of the person designated by the group to accept the check.**

Please complete the Application Form and return to Nuestra by September 5, 2019. You will be assigned an audition number and approximate audition time between 6 and 8 pm.
