



**INFORMATION FOR
SCULPTORS ENTERING THE INSTALLATION COMPETITION
AT "BE THE ARTIST AT BARTLETT" FESTIVAL**

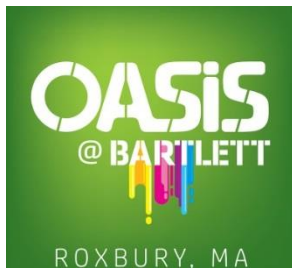
- 1) **Who is eligible to participate?** Any artist living in Roxbury, working in Roxbury, or with roots in Roxbury
- 2) **Are there any special requirements of applicants?** All applicants must be 16 or older and be a practicing artist or art student. All applicants must provide the judging panel with photos or slides of at least one, but preferably several installations completed. These will be returned (if hard copy provided) or can be emailed to Andrea Kaiser, ccstpg@verizon.net. If emailed, the slides or photos must be in a format that can be easily forwarded and opened by the judging panel.

The theme of the installation is "An urban retreat for the body and spirit". The materials used in creating the installation must be either "found objects" or "collected objects". The installation is to be sturdy enough to remain on the site of Bartlett Station for October, November and December. Should weather turn snowy, the installation should be moveable to an indoor space. The maximum dimensions are five feet by five feet by five feet high. All applicants will be able to view the site in advance of submitting drawings.

All candidates must submit a simple drawing of the proposed installation with a description of the materials and design. All drawings and descriptions are to be emailed to Andrea Kaiser at ccstpg@verizon.net no later than September 10th, 2019 at 5:00 pm.

The judging panel will select between three and five finalists who will create installations on-site at 2565 Washington Street, Roxbury, MA (behind Bartlett Station new housing). \$100 will be provided to each finalist for supplies beyond the found or collected materials.

- 3) **What are the prizes?** There is a \$500 prize for 3rd place; a \$1000 prize for 2nd place, and a \$1500 prize for first place.
- 4) **All finalists must be willing to sign a release for photos and video taping of the installation.**
- 5) **All applicants must be available to construct installation on Saturday, September 28, 2019 beginning at 11 AM. The installation must be completed by 4:30 pm that day. Artists may bring assistants to help with the installation and may also utilize festival attendees to assist in completing the projects on time.**
- 6) **When the winning installation is no longer being shown, the artist may request its return and artist must arrange to retrieve the work.**

APPLICATION FORM

Overview: The theme of the installation is: "An Urban Oasis for the Body and Spirit". Artists are required to reside in Roxbury or have a connection to the community in order to qualify.

The artists are being asked to use found and collected objects to create this installation, which must be able to fit in a space that is 5' x 5' by 5' high. Applications must be submitted by September 10, 2019 via email (ccstpg@verizon.net) or regular mail (Nuestra Comunidad CDC, 56 Warren Street, Suite 200, Roxbury, MA 02119). Once the application is received and acknowledged, three finalists will be selected by September 13, 2019 to install the designs at the Festival on Saturday, September 28, 2019 between 11 am and 4:30 pm. All finalists will be paid \$100 for materials to support the installation. The announcement of the awards (1st place \$1,000; 2nd place \$500; and 3rd place \$250) will take place at 5 pm.
