About Us:

Move Over Mozart is an after-school enrichment program that specializes in piano learning. Our program was established in 1988 and is currently offered in 47 elementary schools across Sonoma County.

We are currently in need of a Piano Instructor.

Position Overview:

Piano Instructors guide children through music lesson and theory fundamentals in a group lesson setting. Our after-school program runs from September 2019 - May 2020. Each group lesson is 30-minutes in duration, with 5 students per lesson. Our Piano Instructors are assigned to specific schools throughout the school year. Some schools may have 6-8 group lessons back to back.

During each lesson, Piano Instructors take turns to work with each child one-to-one at the piano; guiding them as they play their lesson book assignments. The Piano Instructor role is supported by the Assistant Piano Instructor, who leads the group activities and focuses on teaching music theory principles from the student workbooks, music-focused games and activities.

Our piano students range from beginner to intermediate in skill-level. We are currently looking to hire Piano Instructors that have a strong background in piano and have had experience teaching. Candidates should be able to commit to 3-5 afternoons per week.

The Ideal Candidate:

Those who apply should have strong leadership skills, a solid background in playing and teaching piano, be punctual, self-starters who can work well with students having diverse skills in a flexible and uplifting manner. All Piano Instructors should have a passion for working with youth and enriching lives through music. The pay for this position starts at \$26 per hour. All applicants must undergo a background check and fingerprinting.
