Tanker/Vehicle Accident	Switch off engine and electrical equipment. Keep people away, warn other traffic. Check for spills, leaks. Call the emergency services: Dial 111								
Spill or leak	Eliminate all ignition sources and naked lights. Use non-sparking utensils. Wear PVC overalls, chemical resistant gloves, facemask or goggles. Prevent further spillage. Adsorb spilled product and place in sealable container for disposal. Wash down affected area with water plus detergent. Absorb and collect washings and place in the same sealable container for disposal. Seek advice from the local authority regarding disposal.								
Fire	Call th	Call the Fire Service: Dial 111. Wear PVC protective clothing and breathing apparatus. Extinguish fires with water spray, fog or foam. During a fire toxic fumes may be released. Cool containers with flooding quantities of water until well after fire is out. Contain run- off. Keep non-involved persons away.
