## "Philosophy of Worship Principles" (Part 8, Section 2) by Dr. Tom Rush

Today's article concludes this series on worship. We pray it has been beneficial to you as we have considered what biblical worship is and what it should look like in the local church! More than anything, it is our prayer that this series has deepened your love for the Lord and your desire to worship Him! Let us be known as a church that regularly and willingly offers up praise to the Lord in spirit and in truth, flowing from hearts full of love and gratitude for our Savior! Influence is another important issue in my mind in the structure of worship. When churches have differing styles of music in several different services, it will be a matter of course that the elderly members will gravitate to the more traditional service and the younger generation will go to the more contemporary service. Do we really want to lose this tremendous force of influence over our younger generations? I shudder to think where I would be today had it not been for the tremendous influence of older saints in the church in which I grew up. I remember in particular the influence of L. H. Thompson. He was the director of the ushers in our church. He took an interest in me and made me a part of the usher crew as a teenager. His influence on my life was significant and had there been a service for "youth" I would have attended that and lost the influence of this godly man in my life.

For the sake of the Kingdom, we must find a way that we can all worship together. Worship should cause us to recognize the greatness of our God and create within us a thirst for a closer walk with the Lord. Pastors and music leaders must work together to create an atmosphere of genuine worship where young and old alike can experience the joy of the Lord, hear from heaven, and leave encouraged to be more faithful in their daily walk with the Lord.


