
Worship Notes

As we continue through the book of Philippians, Bro. Tom will once again focus on the opening two verses of the book by focusing especially on the leadership and members of the church. What constitutes a local church? There are many aspects, but at its core, the church is made up of believers and led by pastors assisted by the deacons. One of the core theological values of Baptist churches is **regenerate church membership**. This is why we do not baptize infants, and we do not have confirmation classes that tend to "graduate" most folks into church membership at a certain age. It is only the individual who has a credible profession of faith and becomes (or has been) biblically baptized who may become a member of Tabernacle Baptist Church.

So, we will focus especially on the saving grace of the Lord Jesus Christ. As a church, we are made up of those who have experienced the rescuing grace of the Lord Jesus Christ in salvation. "Your Grace Is Enough" reminds us of that fact. We are, first and foremost, sinners saved by grace. As followers of Jesus, we are "in Christ." Bro. Tom mentioned that last week. There is a very real personal identification with Jesus Christ and His church, so that believers are described as being "in Christ." As Bro. Tom noted, Muslims do not refer to themselves as being "in Mohammed," etc. Christians, however, are spiritually "in Christ" and members of Christ's body, the church. As such, one of the beauties of the Christian life is that "Jesus is mine" ("Blessed Assurance") and that we are secure in Christ ("He Will Hold Me Fast"). Nothing can undo God's work of grace in our lives! Christ is powerful to save ("Jesus Saves"), and since He is powerful to save, He is also powerful to keep us safe! It is by His grace and mercy that we are saved, and even though are sins are many, "His Mercy Is More!" As powerful as is His grace, so tender are His mercies toward us!

Family Devotional Guide

Day 1

- Scripture: Philippians 1:1; 1 Corinthians 1:2
- Discussion: In the passages above, the apostle Paul refers to saints. In 1 Corinthians 1:2, he refers to the church and clarifies what he means by church: "those who are sanctified in Christ Jesus and called as saints." So, the church is a body of those who are sanctified (set apart) in Christ. Why is it important that church membership be made up only of believers? What is the danger of accepting unbelievers into church membership?
- Song: "The Church's One Foundation" by Samuel J. Stone & Samuel S. Wesley Day 2
- Scripture: Philippians 1:1; 1 Peter 5:1-5; 1 Timothy 3:1-7
- Discussion: The word overseer is synonymous with the term pastor, and our modern term pastor comes from the Latin pastor, which means shepherd and also describes what they do, pastors shepherd. Spend some time praying for your pastors and ask the Lord to help them shepherd faithfully. Ask God to help them be holy men, wholly dedicated to the Lord, fulfilling the qualities laid out in 1 Timothy 3:1-7.

- Discussion: Deacons are a gift to the church. Spend some time thanking God for each of our deacons by name. Pray that the Lord will help them grow in holiness and wisdom as they help our pastors carry out the work of ministry, and encourage them in the selfless work they do for TBC.
