"Worship Notes"

Today is a significant moment in the life of our church! We have adjusted our service times to better reach our community, which is why we are meeting now for Sunday School at 9:15 AM & worship at 10:30 AM. However, that's not the only reason today is significant! This evening we have the honor of observing the Lord's Supper together as a church family. This is one of two ordinances that Christ commanded His church to observe.

If you have repented of your sins and trust in Christ alone for salvation and have been biblically baptized, please come tonight to share this ordinance together with fellow believers! If you do not yet know the Lord Jesus as your Lord and Savior, you are welcome to come observe this moment but without partaking of the bread and juice. This meal symbolizes the body and blood of Christ given for us, but it also points to unity in the body of Christ, the church, and is reserved for believers only. So, while the Lord's Supper is reserved for followers of Jesus, you may learn more about the gospel through observing.

This morning, Bro. Tom will preach on the meaning and importance of the Lord's Supper. With that in mind, we will sing several songs that focus on the blood of Christ, shed for us. **"Victory in Jesus"** reminds us that "He sought [us] and bought [us] with His redeeming blood." This is a fundamental truth that Christ purchased a people to Himself on the cross! **"Are You Washed in the Blood?"** conveys an important question for our consideration. It is only the "soul-cleansing blood of the Lamb" that ensures our salvation! We must also remember that Christ has conquered the grave through His sacrifice on the cross and is currently "seated on His throne" (**"Worthy Is the Lamb"**). The choir will follow by singing explicitly of the substitutionary atoning death of Christ on the cross (**"I Come to the Cross"**), remembering the Savior who "died in my place." We'll end our service with a reminder of the love of God. His love is strong and intentional, not sentimental or fleeting. When we sing **"Jesus Loves Me,"** we're reminded of being in chains and needing rescued from our sins which held us bound (in fact, we were "dead in trespasses" according to Eph. 2:5).

The Lord's Supper should humble us as we consider all that God has done for us! We do not deserve the salvation Christ provided for us, so may our response be one of humble gratitude and sincere worship!

Family Devotional Guide

Day 1

- **Scripture:** Galatians 6:11-18
- **Discussion:** : Paul ends his letter to the Galatians with a focus on salvation by grace through the cross of Christ. He says that his only boast is “in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ.” In the Lord’s Supper, our focus is explicitly on the cross of Christ. How should the cross humble us? Spend time thanking our Lord for His sacrifice for us!

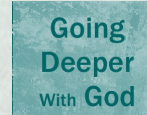
