Worship Notes

This morning, Bro. Tom will focus on excellence in the Christian life. That excellence comes about as we display the fruit of righteousness, living righteously for God's glory. We are also just a few weeks away from Christmas, so the worship music in our service tends to focus on Christmas. Consider the connection between living righteously and the birth of Christ. The fact that Christ came and dwelt among us (John 1:14) means that Christ fulfilled the law. He lived a perfect human life, a righteous life, a life we cannot live! He fulfilled the law's demands so that we can trust in Him alone for salvation and receive forgiveness of our sins.

We will begin our service with a fife duet by Drew Edge and Isaac Young. Drew participates in Civil War reenactments with his friend, Isaac, who ministers to the reenactors there as on behalf of his church. As they play "The First Noel" and the "Doxology," consider that these two songs have most likely been common on battlefields the world over through the years. Make it a point this Christmas to pray for our troops stationed over-

As we consider the Messiah lying in a manger many years ago, our songs today should remind us of several things:

Christ is King! He was "born the king of angels" ("O Come, All Ye Faithful")! His humble birth did not fully reveal His majesty. In fact, the reality of His humble birth was a deliberate choice (see Philippians 2).

Christ is divine! He is "God with us" ("Emmanuel").

Christ is Savior! As "Come Behold the Wondrous Mystery" phrases it, Christ "condescended, took on flesh to ransom us." He came to save! That was His purpose, as evidenced in His name, Jesus (cf. Matthew 1:21).

Christ is Reconciler! The choir piece, "Song of Joy with Hark! The Herald Angels Sing" includes a line from the classic carol: "God and sinners reconciled!" That's the message of 2 Corinthians 5:19, and what a sweet message it is!

After Bro. Tom preaches on excellence in the Christian life, we have the opportunity to respond by asking the Lord to take our lives and all that we have and use it for His glory ("Take My Life"). May that not only be a song from our lips, but the prayer from our hearts!


