Update from Jenni for Jimmy Carter

Each time I send out a prayer update I look back at the previous one just to see what I sent. As I look over the one I sent the first of September I realize how far Jimmy has come. Two month ago he was just stopping the use of his cane, but still needed to wear the gait belt so that we could help him stay steady. Obviously now he walks well without any assistance. His right leg is still a little slower than his left leg, but it's getting better. He finally had the groshong removed the first part of October which was a huge step in his recovery. Once it was removed he was able to start Physical

Therapy as well as Occupational Therapy. He continues to go twice a week for both. He has had several setbacks over the last few months. He developed a kidney stone and had to have lithotripsy to help pass the stone, he developed a terrible rash (still not sure if it was some of the meds – but it's better), and now he has a cold. While a cold is an inconvenience for most of us, our fear is that his will develop into another infection or abscess somewhere in his body. But he is on an antibiotic now and will probably be on one for the rest of his life. His right arm and shoulder is now the main focus for his complete rehabilitation. In addition to the outpatient rehab, he does exercises at home and we have electrodes that I put on him for thirty minutes each day to help coax the shoulder muscles to work again. (It's pretty fascinating to watch). Overall, we are pleased with his progress and can see the light at the end of this dark tunnel. Hopefully before I send out another Prayer Update, he'll be back to work. Thank you so much for your prayers
