Worship Notes

On this Sunday before Thanksgiving, my prayer is that the Lord will continually stir our hearts for things for which we should be thankful. And let us not forget that thanksgiving and praise are intricately connected. As we thank God for Who He is and all He has done, we are also praising Him for those things in song. So, let us consider some things that should stir our hearts toward gratitude:

1. We have blessings that we can count. The song “Count Your Blessings” encourages us to “name them one by one.” Often, the cure for worry and pessimism is a careful consideration of what we have. Dennis Prager has put forth the missing tile syndrome as a theory of happiness. There can be 1,000 tiles in a room, but we can fixate on why one tile is missing. Too often in life, we focus on the things we don't have, but if we were to stop and count off our blessings, how quickly our disposition and attitude would change!

2. We have blessings that we cannot count. In particular, were we to spend time thanking God for Who He is, we'd find “**10,000 Reasons**” and more (obviously, the line is meant to imply an infinitude). Imagine spending just 5 seconds thanking God for a single one of His attributes. An entire lifetime still couldn't suffice to adequately thank God! There are also things that God has done for us that we are not aware of, particularly in guarding us from dangers or providing for our needs without our direct knowledge.

3. We have the blessing of salvation and its result, sanctification. “Jesus Saves” serves to remind us of one of the central truths of Scripture, the gospel! One of the beautiful aspects of the gospel is that God doesn't save us and leave us alone. Instead, He saves us and continues making us more and more like Jesus, the message the choir will convey in “**He Who Began a Good Work in You**” (drawn from a verse from today's sermon, Philippians 1:6—“being confident of this very thing, that He who has begun a good work in you will complete it until the day of Jesus Christ”).

So, what is the end result of considering all these things? It should be, “**My Heart Is Filled with Thankfulness.**” May God stir in us a deeper gratitude for all the things He has done for us!

Family Devotional Guide

Day 1

- **Scripture:** Philippians 1:3-5
- **Discussion:** Spend some time thanking God for the fellow believers He has placed in your life. What are some practical ways you can express gratitude to others? Consider the depth of meaning in the phrase "fellowship in the gospel."
- **Song:** "The Church's One Foundation" by Samuel J. Stone & Samuel S. Wesley

Day 2

- **Scripture:** Philippians 1:6
- **Discussion:** God never saves a person only to leave them alone. He always continues His work of making them more like Jesus—sanctification. Discuss some ways God has changed you since you became a Christian. Spend some time praying for any new believers that you know who are just beginning the Christian life, often one of the most challenging times for a Christian.
- **Song:** "Higher Ground" by Charles H. Gabriel & Johnson Oatman, Jr.

Day 3

- **Scripture:** Philippians 1:7-8
- **Discussion:** The apostle Paul knew persecution, and the chains that he mentioned were literal. Notice that he said the believers in Philippi were "partakers with me of grace." What are the implications when we consider that we are partaking of the same grace as our persecuted brothers and sisters across the world? Spend some time thanking God for those who are spreading the gospel in a dangerous land. Also, consider how the Lord may be leading you to give to the Lottie Moon Christmas offering to support the work of missionaries across the world.

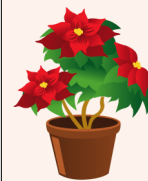
