The Perils of Ignoring Preaching

Second Chronicles 18:4

Introduction:

Mark 2:24 - "Take heed WHAT you hear..." - Jesus

Luke 18:8 - "Take heed HOW you hear..." - Jesus

James 1:22 - "But be DOERS of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves." - James

The preaching we are not to ignore is:

- **1. Sound in DOCTRINE.** The Message is Certain. (2 Ch. 17)
- **2. Sound in DUTY.** The Morality is Clear. (Cf. 2 Kings 22:46; 2 Tim. 4:2-3)

I. REVIVAL comes through INSTRUCTION & INSPIRATION from the BIBLE (2 Chron. 17:3, 4, 7, 9)

Result:

- 1. Kingdom Established, 17:5
- 2. Fear of the Lord Evident, 17:10
- 3. Riches & Honor Abundant, 18:1

In the church:

- 1. True Gospel Church Established
- 2. Evangelism & Discipleship are Central
- 3. The Riches of Spiritual Maturity are obvious

++BUT - Wherever revival is breaking out the enemy will come in like a flood

II. REBELLION comes through IGNORANCE & INDIFFER-ENCE to the BIBLE (2 Chron. 18:1-7)

How did Jehoshaphat get into his dilemma? How do we get into similar dilemmas?

- -Jehoshaphat "allied himself with Ahab."
- 1. The Military Alliance.
- 2. The Marriage Alliance.
- 3. The Market Alliance
- -Jehoshaphat *IGNORED* the very preaching he had ordered done throughout the land of Judah.
- -Even a lost man, Ahab, knew the difference in a real preacher and a false one! But he hated the true man of God!
- -Jehoshaphat gets what he asked for the truth from a man of God, and then he ignores it. In consequence he faces FIVE PERILS:
- #1. HIS WALK IS DEFEATED.
- **#2. HIS WISDOM IS DILUTED.**
- #3. HIS WORSHIP IS DISCOURAGED.
- #4. HIS WITNESS WAS DESTROYED.
- **#5. HIS WORKS WERE DEFILED.**

The Perils of Ignoring the Preaching ... It will cost you your ...

PEACE, Phil 4:7 PERSUASIVENESS, 2 Cor. 5:11

PATIENCE, Col. 1:11 PRAISE, Heb. 13:5 PERFECTION, Heb. 5 & 6 POWER, 2 Pet. 1:3
