Worship Notes by Kenny Wells

We are excited to have Dr. Gregory Frizzell this weekend for our Going Deeper with God conference. Our prayer is that this conference is already helping you draw closer to the Lord! James 4:8 tells us, "Draw near to God, and he will draw near to you. Cleanse your hands, you sinners, and purify your hearts, you double-minded." There is a promise and a warning here. The **promise** is that when you draw near to God, He draws near to you! So, if you take a step closer, so does He. 1 step = 2 steps! The **warning** is implied by the command to cleanse your hands and purify your hearts. The implication here is that you cannot expect to draw near to the Lord if you're harboring sin! As Dr. Frizzell has pointed out in the book we're using for our prayer series, we must heed the warning of Psalm 66:18—"If I regard iniquity in my heart, the Lord will not hear."

Today, we will focus especially on **drawing near to the Lord** and **a revival leading to holiness!** As we think of the Lord and personal holiness, we find some truths from today's songs that will hopefully deepen our understanding:

1. Personal revival is something God must do. Our first song is a prayer, "**Revive Us Again.**" Drawing near to the Lord means relying on Him to do a work of revival that we cannot do. Just as we cannot save ourselves, we also cannot grow in holiness without His work in our hearts. We *must* rely on the power of the Holy Spirit.

2. Drawing near to God means focusing on Him and understanding Him rightly. One of my favorite quotes is by A.W. Tozer: "What comes into our minds when we think about God is the most important thing about us." As we seek to draw near to the Lord, we must make sure we are drawing near to the God of the Bible! "**How Great Is Our God**" and "**Behold Our God**" remind us that God is highly exalted and worthy of praise. Especially as we sing "Behold Our God," consider all the wonderful truths that song contains and Who God is and what He does.

3. Drawing near to God means submitting to Him and His will. This is where the rubber meets the road! The choir song, "**Bow the Knee,**" focuses particularly on trusting the Lord when times are tough. Few things reveal to us our level of spiritual maturity like suffering. We'll end our service with a call to surrender all to Jesus Christ. As we sing "**I Surrender All,**" may the words not be hollow, but in fact a genuine reflection of our desire to obey Jesus.
