## Worship Notes by Kenny Wells

This morning, Bro. Tom will preach one of two introductory messages to set up his series preaching through the book of Philippians. In today's message, he'll focus on the Macedonian call. The apostle Paul lived a missionary life focused on others and bringing them the good news of salvation in Christ alone. He was also obedient to the Lord and followed His leadership. In today's unique passage, the Holy Spirit and the Lord prevented them from preaching the gospel on two separate occasions. However, Paul knew the Lord had a purpose and a plan, as shown to Paul in a dream of a man begging for help in Macedonia, and they were obedient to follow.

Today's music will hopefully encourage us to share the gospel and be obedient to the Lord. As we come together to worship, we come as believers who have submitted our lives to Jesus and worship Him in Spirit and in truth. So, we'll begin our service with a call to do just that ("Come, People of the Risen King"). We'll be encouraged to share our faith as we sing "Send the Light." As we sing that song, consider whether there is a Macedonian call already placed in your own heart and mind, possibly a Macedonian call. Is there someone in your path who you know needs Jesus. Maybe your plans would be different, but the Lord is making it clear certain individuals or areas that should be in your evangelistic sights. "Across the Lands" further challenges us to be obedient to Christ who is "the Lord of every man" and share His gospel with all, knowing that His "cry of love rings out across the lands."

The choir piece, "Power of the Cross," and our song of invitation, "O Great God," teach us about the power of the gospel to save. We are not sharing a powerless message of a powerless Savior, and God forbid that we treat the gospel or our Savior as such! We are sharing the message of the power of Christ to save through His sacrifice on the cross, and He is able to open up spiritually blind eyes and deaf ears. So, let us share the gospel (and sing of the gospel!) with confidence!
