Worship Notes by Kenny Wells

In today's message, Bro. Tom will focus on the Macedonian conversions we find in Acts 16, and our songs today will focus on each of these individuals.

LYDIA – Set free from *delusion*

Lisa Johnson will open our service with a solo, “**Great Things**,” and you are welcome to sing along if you know it. It is appropriate that this song opens our service since it also sheds light on the first conversion of today's passage, Lydia! We must remember that salvation is a work that God does (see Acts 16:14), and it is a “great thing!” Just as Lydia's heart had to be opened, we, too, are not interested in spiritual matters and cannot understand them (1 Corinthians 2:14) until God does some heart work on us! Lydia was religiously deluded, but not born again, and only the Lord could reveal that to her and save her!

THE SLAVE GIRL – Set free from *deception*

The slave girl had to be delivered from her “spirit of divination”—a demonic spirit with knowledge that helped her accrue wealth for her masters through fortune-telling (Acts 16:16). “**All I Have Is Christ**” speaks to her condition—“I once was lost in darkest night, yet thought I knew the way. The sin that promised joy and life had led me to the grave.” Yes, this situation may be a little unusual compared to what we experience, but our bondage to sin is no less extreme, just different. We, too, must be delivered!

THE JAILER– Set free from *despair*

The jailer needed to be set free from his despair! The same is true of us! The two gospel songs by Bill Gaither speak of that need. “**He Touched Me**” describes being “shackled by a heavy burden” and “Neath a load of guilt and shame.” The glorious thought to consider is that Christ reaches down and touches us with deliverance and salvation, so that “Now I am no longer the same.” “**Because He Lives**” reminds us that Christ also relieves our despair with the peace that comes from knowing that He has risen and is reigning from heaven (and that we, if we're trusting in Him for salvation, will be raised to eternal life in heaven).

So, the answer for each person (indeed, every person) is Jesus Christ! The way to reach the answer is simply to come and “**Kneel at the Cross.**” The answer is a Person, Jesus, and the way to reach Him is to come to Him through faith and by grace! So, come today if you don't know Jesus as your Lord & Savior. Come to the cross and find that “Jesus will meet you there!”
