




WHAT DO YOU NEED?

- PAPER
- SOMETHING TO WRITE WITH

OPTIONAL:

- PENCILS, PENS & PENCIL CRAYONS
- MAGAZINES (TO CUT OUT & COLLAGE)
- PAINT & MARKERS
- SPONGES & PAINT BRUSHES
- TAPE
- GLUE
- ACCESS TO A PHOTOCOPIER (TO MAKE COPIES)



STEP 1: BRAINSTORM

 THINK OF SOMETHING THAT YOU WANT PEOPLE TO KNOW ABOUT. SOMETHING IMPORTANT.
 SOMETHING YOU'D LIKE TO SHARE?



STEP 2: MAKE IT!

- YOU MIGHT WANT TO USE COLLAGE (CUTTING & GLUING IMAGES & TEXT) OR MAKE A COMIC OR WRITE OR DRAW.
- THERE ARE LOTS OF WAYS TO MAKE A ZINE!



STEP 3: SHARE IT!

- AFTER YOU ARE HAPPY WITH YOUR ZINE, SHARE IT WITH OTHERS. YOU MIGHT WANT TO UPLOAD IT ONLINE, OR MAKE PHOTOCOPIES, OR DRAW/WRITE MULTIPLE COPIES.
- ZINES ARE MEANT TO BE DISTRIBUTED & SHARED!
