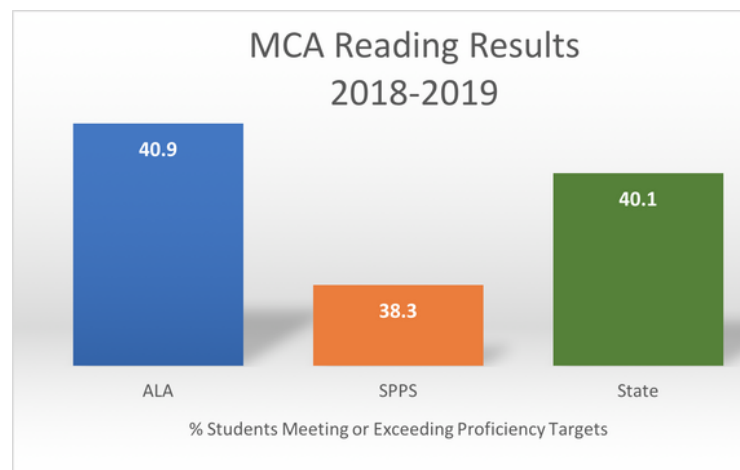
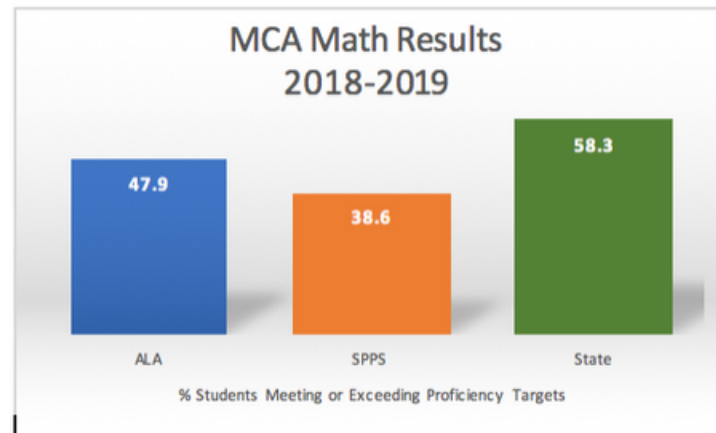


Achieve Language Academy

All students in public schools are required to participate in the statewide assessment program called the Minnesota Comprehensive Assessment (MCA). At Achieve, reading and mathematics tests are administered in grades 3–8; and science in grades 5 and 8. With very few exceptions, all public school students in the above grades take the MCA.

As part of our goals with our charter school Authorizer, Novation Education Opportunities or NEO, Achieve Language Academy administers these tests to our students in grades 3-8. We compare statewide data as well as the data of our neighboring districts to see how we compare. Specifically, we look at St Paul Public Schools (SPPS) as it is the largest representation of student populations similar to ours. ALA continues to grow and accept new challenges unique to our diverse learning community.

The graphs shown compare our data to that of the state as well as SPPS.

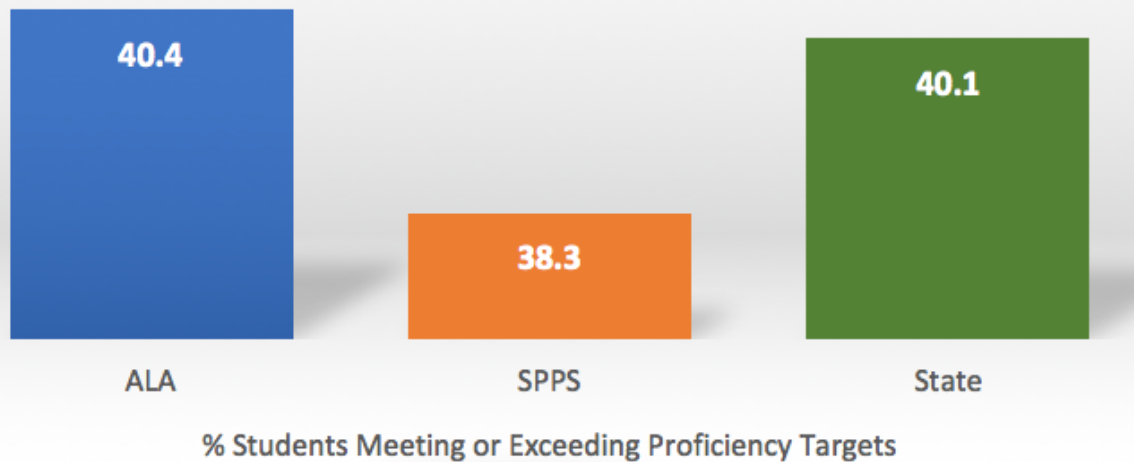

Progress Towards ELP 2018-2019



ACCESS for ELLs is a test developed by the World-class Instructional Design and Assessment or *WIDA* consortium. The state of Minnesota has determined that all English learners are administered this test. It is designed to measure progress toward meeting Minnesota's standards for English language development. Most English learners will take the *ACCESS for ELLs*. The graph to the right shows how well our students are progressing to English language proficiency, or ELP.

Achieve Language Academy continues to maintain similar high numbers to the state as well exceeding St Paul Public Schools.

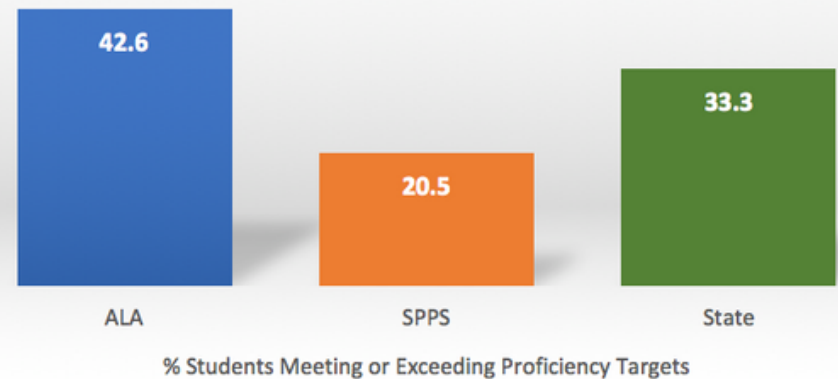
Students who received Free and Reduced Lunch or FRP
