EVENTS All events will be swum as mixed events and scored as male & female. Heats

will be swum with all age groups combined and swimmers seeded by entry

times.

INDIVIDUAL EVENT 200m Backstroke, Breaststroke, Butterfly, Freestyle & Individual Medley 100m Backstroke, Breaststroke, Butterfly & Freestyle & Individual Medley

50m Backstroke, Breaststroke, Butterfly & Freestyle

SKINS Event The Skins event at this meet will provide challenge and entertainment in equal

measure!

There will be a Men's and Women's event, the lucky winners receiving prizes! Qualification to the 'showdown' will be through the 'gateway' event of the 100metres Individual Medley. (As such, there is no additional cost for the SKINS – the 100IM would form part of your initial entry fee for one of your five events)

- The fastest six males and females will qualify for their respective SKINS FINAL.
- 2. The qualifiers will be spearheaded.
- 3. Each race will consist of a 25m sprint.
- 4. Each length will have a 2 minute turnaround.
- 5. The stroke will be dictated by a 'blind pick' from a bag.
- 6. The starter will 'pick' the first stroke of each final.
- 7. The first start will be a conventional start (take your marks.)
- 8. The last swimmer in each race will be eliminated.
- The eliminated swimmer will then 'blind select' the stroke that the following race will swim.
- Each race thereafter will be started by way of '10 second warning' by way of whistle, followed by starting beep for a go (no take your marks!)
- 11. After 5 rounds the person 'still standing' is the winner.

Judges word is final!

Whilst the 100IM will form part of any cumulative scores for age group awards, the FINAL will not draw any additional points – ITS FOR FUN!

AGE Age is at 31st December 2019, all competitors must be age 16 years or older

by this date.

AWARDS

Medals will be awarded to the top three in age group for each race and an overall prize for each age group winners.

Skins events are not categorized into age groups, prizes will be awarded to top six in both male and female events.

The presentation ceremony will take place immediately after Session 2 in the Olympia Cafe

All medals can be collected at the pool during the event. Age group and Skins prizes will be awarded at the award ceremony in the Olympia Cafe immediately after the championships.

WITHDRAWALS

To arrive no later than 5pm Sunday 22nd September 2019, withdrawals after this date will not be entitled to a refund

All details must be included on e-mail withdrawals i.e. Name, Event No, Stroke, SASA No. etc.

Telephone withdrawals will not be accepted under any circumstances.

Withdrawals on the day should be submitted to the recorders table at the top of the balcony at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the session.

Please note that anyone withdrawing on medical grounds, refunds will only be granted on production of a letter from a suitably qualified professional confirming withdrawal is recommended. The letter must be received within 7 days following the meet and should be dated no earlier than the closing date or later than 3 days from the date of the competition.

MARSHALLING

There will be no marshalling for the event swimmers should be at the blocks for their race at the appropriate time. Missed swims will not be refunded.

- 1.
