



Want to ROCK the SAT/ACT? FREE Test Prep for Juniors

- ◆ **To qualify for admission to most four-year universities, students must take an SAT or ACT.** We strongly encourage students to participate in a **free workshop** to prepare them to do well on the SAT and/or ACT. Test scores are an extremely important factor that can affect whether a student is admitted to his/her first-choice university. Earning a competitive score is crucial. These workshops teach helpful tips, tricks and strategies.
- ◆ **Workshop Content:** Students will learn about both the SAT and ACT and work on sample questions from both exams. They will learn strategies for every section (reading, grammar, math, science and the essays.) The workshop is targeted to juniors, but younger students are welcome to attend. Parents are also welcome. If you can't attend January 25, there will be a make-up workshop on April 18.

SAT: www.collegeboard.org. SAT: \$64.50 with Essay or \$49.50 without Essay
ACT: www.actstudent.org. ACT: \$68 with Writing or \$52 without Writing

Register online to take the SAT and/or ACT. All universities in the USA accept either test or will take your higher score if you take both. If you take either test more than once, most universities will use your highest score. You must pay with credit card, PayPal, check, money order, or **fee waiver**. Visit a high school counselor to see if you qualify for a fee waiver, which makes the test free. **If you took the October 2019 PSAT as a junior and used a College Board Fee Waiver, you might have SAT fee waivers already banked in your College Board account.* **Spring SAT Dates:** March 14, May 2, June 6. **Spring ACT Dates:** February 8, April 4, June 13, July 18. **Register before the deadlines in order to secure a spot and avoid late fees.**

Not sure whether to include the optional Essay? Check to see if your college of choice requires or recommends the Essay. CSUs, including SDSU, do NOT require the Essay, UCs require the Essay.
