Canada Roller Derby expands operations to include Team Canada Men's Roller Derby and Sport Development division

In 2019 Canada Roller Derby is expanding its operations to include a Sport Development branch as well as management of the men's national team, Team Canada Men's Roller Derby.

Canada Roller Derby background and organization

Canada Roller Derby was incorporated in 2017 as a membership-based non-profit organization with a mission to develop the sport of roller derby; to build and develop national teams of the highest calibre; and to build an organization to support and grow the sport across Canada and serve as the de facto organizing body for the sport in Canada. The organization began as an initiative of the national women's team, Team Canada Women's Roller Derby. Its plans for expansion began with community consultation which led to a strategic plan that included goals of creating development programs, helping to build a network with provincial roller derby organizations, and possible alignment of the men's, women's and junior national teams.

With these new developments, Canada Roller Derby now includes three branches within its Performance division: Sport Development, led by Head of Sport Development Jessica Paternostro; the Team Canada Men's Roller Derby national team, led by Head Coach Bethany Fisher; and the Team Canada Women's Roller Derby national team, whose coaching staff will be hired in 2019. Each branch coordinates with a centralized Operations division and reports to a volunteer Board of Directors active within the roller derby community.

Sport Development branch

Addressing the organization's mission to develop the sport of roller derby, Canada Roller Derby has engaged former Team Canada Women's and Men's

Coach and Team Canada skater Jessica Paternostro as Head of Sport Development. Paternostro is responsible for overseeing the creation of programs for coach, officials-, and athlete development and certification. Her first initiative is to develop a roller derby coaching certification program. Says Paternostro, "Coach development is an area that is lacking within roller derby in Canada. This is why I'm excited to

work alongside our national and existing provincial organizations to develop a coaching certification program. I hope to foster a community of practice for all Canadian coaches to ensure the growth of this wonderful sport."

Team Canada Men's Roller Derby

In November 2018 Team Canada Men's Roller Derby announced a 32-person training roster for the 2020 Men's Roller Derby World Cup, scheduled for 9-12 July in St. Louis. Head Coach Bethany Fisher is supported by Assistant Coach Alicia Biggley and Line Coach Alexandra Evans. All three coaches skated for Team Canada Women at the last Roller Derby World Cup. In previous editions of the Men's Roller Derby World Cup, Team Canada Men placed third in Birmingham 2014, fourth in Calgary in 2016, and fifth in Barcelona in 2018.
