

# The History of Our Bible and Scripture

# The History of Our Bible and Scripture

- Book compiled from oral tradition and Divine Inspiration

#### Exodus, Leviticus, Numbers & Deuteronomy

- Written by Moses (or at his direction) based on firsthand experience and interaction with God.
- Lost in Babylonian captivity, recovered by Nehemiah and Ezra. Translated from Ancient Hebrew to Aramaic, Temple worship and sacrifice restored.

#### Old Testament Translated to Greek (Septuagint LXX(70))

- Translated about 300 BC, shortly after the death of Alexander the Great, at the request of Ptolemy II Philadelphus for the famous Alexandria Library. (BTW: Included Daniel)
- This was "The Bible" in Jesus' day.

#### Apocrypha & Catholic Bible

• Includes "deuterocanonical" books Tobit, Judith, 1 and 2 Maccabees and others. These books are usually not found in the Protestant Bible, but are sometimes included in a separate inter-testamental section called the "Apocrypha".

#### The New Testament


- Can be put into two groups based on their underlying Greek text.
- Critical Text (or Catholic Text) about 45 manuscripts
- Received Text (Protestant Bible) about 5200 manuscripts
  - Translated by William Tyndale who was burned at the stake by Rome in 1536

A death sentence was decreed for anyone who dared to even own a Tyndale Bible—a sentence carried out on many. The English Bible was revised and refined, reaching its zenith in the Authorized King James Bible (KJB).

Today, most versions of the bible have converged on the word of God and differ only in style and grammar.

(With a few exceptions.)

- (4) verbal adj. of the root No. 3, a lier in wait, Ps. 49:6.

So I believe a valid translation *could* be "He will crush your evil deeds and you will crush the rear of His army"








## The Snake on A Pole Numbers 21:4-9
