Storytelling Directions



John saw Jesus sitting on a throne. There was bright light around Him. John saw that everything bad had ended. There was a new heaven and a new earth. No one was sick. No one was sad or crying. No one died. Then John saw a beautiful city with a high wall and gates. He saw some of God's angels. He saw a flowing river and the tree of life with many kinds of fruit. People were happy and praising God. John wrote down what he saw. It is written in the last book of the Bible, called the Book of Revelation. No one knows what the new heaven and earth will look like for sure. But we know it will be a beautiful, happy place because that's what God's angel showed John.

Before Jesus went back to heaven, He told His helper friends about the new heaven and earth too. These words are also for us. He says, "I know you have had some happy days. But I'm getting a place ready for you where you'll be happier than ever before! That place is My Father's house. My Father's house is prettier than anything you've ever seen. It has lots of room and it's very beautiful! The streets are gold and the gates have jewels. You will love the special place I have ready for you.

"In My house, everyone is happy all the time! No one will ever get sick. No one will get hurt or cut or bruised. No one will ever make you cry or tease you. No one will say or do anything wrong. And best of all, you'll get to see Me! We'll talk with one another. You'll get to see the angels and God's friends that you've been learning about—Paul, Philip, Stephen, David, Moses, and all the rest! You'll see the people you love who believe in Me too! You can sing and be happy together.

"I'm getting this beautiful home ready for you because I love you so much! You are special to Me. I died on the cross to pay for your sins and rose again so you can live with Me always. I promise to give you this forever home someday."


Today I learned . .

- Who will be with them there?







Connect the dots. What did you make? Draw yourself inside. Jesus gives you a home and family.


Jesus promises to give you a forever home too. Add stickers to show who will be there. Look for the happy faces. What happy things will you do there?

Follow the path to help the children get to Jesus as they did in Luke 18:16.




