

Proposal to increase dues by withdrawing from BCA membership. The proposal will lower the overall cost of league membership for teams consisting of 5 or 6 members by eliminating \$15.00 BCA dues and increasing dues by \$30.00 a season. For a six player team this would be an increase of \$5.00 a season. For a 4 player team, the increase would be \$7.50 a season, which would be the same cost as now, only the league would get the money instead of BCA.

Current rule:

- Teams and Members.
 - A team will consist of a minimum of four (4) members and a maximum of six (6) members

B. Each team will have a player designated as captain.

C. A team will submit the names (first and last), addresses, and telephone numbers of its captain and players at the registration meeting.

D. Cost is \$230 per team. Team dues are due and to be paid in full by the end of the first Captain's Meeting.

E. Each player is responsible for Billiards Congress of American (BCA) dues (currently \$15.00 a year The BCA calendar runs from June 1st to May 31)

F. All members of the Long Beach Pool League must be at least 21 years of age.

The new rule would read.

1.1.2. Teams and members

A. A team will consist of a minimum of four (4) members and a maximum of six (6)

- Each team will have a member designated as captain.
- A team will submit the names (first and last), addresses, and telephone numbers of its captain and players at the registration meeting.

D. Cost is \$260 per team. Team dues are to be paid in full by the end of the first Captain's Meeting.

E. All members of the Long Beach Pool League must be 21 years of age.

By removing BCA membership we also eliminate the following rules:

1.1.3 G Acceptance of membership in the LBPL shall also constitute membership in BCA. Membership, including but not limited to participation in BCA tournaments.
