**PREREQUISITE:** None.

**HOW TO DO THIS COURSE:** Do the steps one at a time, in order. When you finish a step, put your initials and the date on the sign-off line on the right. A split line means get a pass (and an initial) from another student (or your supervisor if it says that).

**PURPOSE:** Learn basic arithmetic facts and do arithmetic much more quickly and with certainty.

#### MATERIALS NEEDED FOR THIS COURSE-

The appropriate set of arithmetic facts cards.

## DRILLING INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. The coach arranges the cards of a group randomly. (Note: The cards can be first drilled in order if the student has great difficulty when they are random. But before a student passes on any group he must be able to do them randomly.)
- 2. The coach goes through the cards showing the student the answer side and stating each fact (coach says "3 + 2 is 5") as he shows it. (This step may be omitted after the student can get most of the answers on his own.)
- 3. The coach shows the student the questions side of the cards, with the student stating the answer only. (Card says "3 + 2", student says "5".) If the student cannot give the answer within 4 to 5 seconds, or gives a wrong answer, the coach tells the student the correct answer and puts the card in the back of the pack.
- 4. Taking out the cards the student knew, repeat steps 2 (if needed) and 3 with the one left. Then repeat this.

A student is finished with a group of cards when he can give all of the right answers quickly. (For ages 6-12.5, the response rate should be within a second or two. For ages 12.5 and above a response rate of less than 1 second should be expected..)

- 1. DEMONSTRATE (with whatever objects you wish to use): Student demonstrates that he understands the ideas of the facts that he is learning.
