

Artificial Grass Pitch for Cobham RFC - Rules of Use

Pitch 2 at Cobham Rugby club is an Artificial Grass pitch, also known as AGP or 4G pitch. All age groups will at some point be playing on this pitch.

Detailed below are a number of rules and recommendations to ensure the longevity of the surface and for players' safety and enjoyment.

Rules of Use

- · Access to the pitch will only be via the holding pen for boot cleaning
- · All boots need to be clean
- Only players and coaches on the new grass
- · All spectators need to be behind the fence
- · No food or chewing gum on pitch
- · No drinks allowed on the pitch except water
- · No smoking or naked flames
- No animals

Recommended Footwear for a sand & rubber infill AGP

Allowed

- Boots with plastic moulded studs
- · Boots with plastic or rubber studs
- Synthetic turf trainers
- · Boots with metal or metal tipped studs

Not Recommended (and will not be allowed during the 2020/2021 season)

· Boots with plastic blades

Not allowed

• Flat soled shoes e.g. trainers (except for First Aiders)
