### **OpenDoor Principles and 16 Core Values**

# 1. Unity makes us a conduit for God's Power.

Unity is not rank and file behind a pastor's authority. Unity is the intentional practice of love towards each other. We believe the power of God moves through the relationship of the people in the service not just through a church service. So if we want the power of God to be manifest among us then we have to be people that attack division and not each other.

And the LORD said, Behold, the people is one, and they have all one language; and this they begin to do; and now nothing will be restrained from them, which they have imagined to do.

### 2. We Value Character Before Charisma

# 3. We Express the Nature of God

#### 11. Restoration is Greater than Punishment

The ministry that Christ has given us is not a ministry of judgment and punishment. That's not to say there's not discernment and accountability, but it is also not to say that the Father's business is to ridicule and alienate.

# 12. Blessed to be a Blessing

I have a covenant mandate and destiny to be a blessing to the whole Earth. I'm not fighting for blessing I am fighting from blessing. All that God has made me and given me is for me to give in advancement of His Kingdom and there is much more coming.

# 13. Stewardship and Not Ownership

Stewardship is when you take care of somebody else's money, time or property. God can expect a return from the coins he has trusted me with. I don't mind taking commanded risks and giving things up because none of it is mine anyways.

# 14. I am Made to Accomplish Vision

Every born again believer is physically and supernaturally formed to achieve the ridiculous. Being "on vision" is all about pressing forward towards the mark past excuse and circumstance. Selfishness translates into a work ethic and can't complete objectives and a life that can't multitask or move with God on endless levels. None of that is for us.

## 15. I live with Awareness that Nothing is Impossible

Past the probable and the improbable is the impossible and that what we launch out into. Ministry leaders have constantly mixed the practical with the impossible while making sure we maintain a culture of constant hope.

#### 16. No Matter the Cost

According to the Parable of Luke 14 and according to anybody that has ever built anything, the actual cost is always more than the initial perspective. The building side of the church must be staffed with people that are willing to make whatever sacrifice is necessary to finish the work. Anyone that keeps count will eventually decide they have paid too much and bail out before completion. The Parable of Luke 14 is not to see if we have enough money but to see if we have the willingness to pay whatever is necessary.

- WE BELIEVE that unity makes us a conduit for God's power and as a community of Christians we are a much more powerful tool within the kingdom and on this earth.
- o WE BELIEVE that a church service should be all about an encounter with God and equipping and edifying the saints. Sometimes there will be more of an emphasis on worship and sometimes more on teaching, we should be Spirit led in determining what that priority should be from season to season.
