Week 4

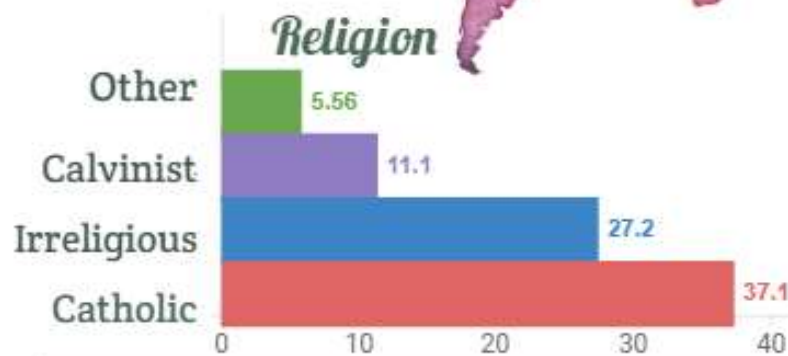
