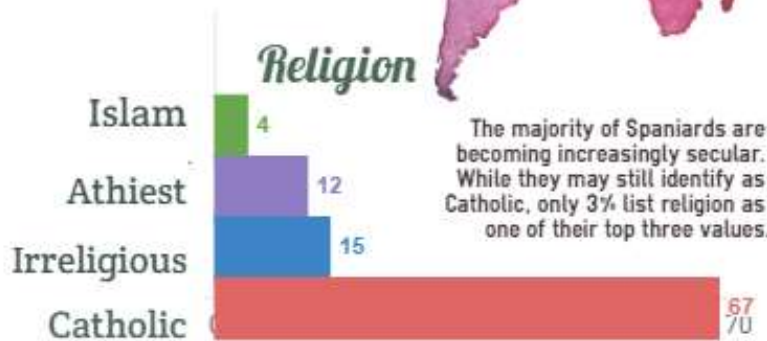


Planted Seeds

Week 1

Pray for the People *"First of all, then, I urge that entreaties and prayers, petitions and thanksgivings, be made on behalf of all men," 1 Timothy 2:2*

- People made aware of their need of Christ
- Peace and joy found in Jesus

Week 2

Pray for the Nation *"for kings and all who are in authority, so that we may lead a tranquil and quiet life in all godliness and dignity. 1 Timothy 2:3*

- God to raise up godly leaders in government
- Solutions to a drug epidemic which ranks as one of Europe's largest

Week 3

Pray for the Church *"This is good and acceptable in the sight of God our Savior, who desires all men to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth." 1 Timothy 2:3-4*

- Pray for the new location of Light Madrid in the heart of downtown. Light Madrid is creating a space that encourages people to have real conversations, meet new friends, and lead to Gospel-sharing opportunities.
- Large evangelistic campaign that will happen this summer in Madrid. The church is praying for 5000 people to accept Jesus as their savior. Light Madrid is helping to organize and train all the volunteers who will counsel and talk to people during the event.

Week 4

Pray for the missionaries *"praying at the same time for us as well, that God will open up to us a door for the word, so that we may speak forth the mystery of Christ."*
