4. Please make sure you have sensible clothes and a fitting hard hat.
5. Please make sure your horse vaccines and treatments are up to date.
6. Please be respectful and kind to your conduct. Do not ride in such a way that someone else gets hurt.
7. Please make sure your horse is not a danger to others and remember to add a red ribbon to the tail if your pony kicks.

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Indemnity Form

1.I acknowledge and accept that there are inherent dangers in horse riding and fully understand the nature of the risk and need for the rider to take all reasonable precautions. It is advised that each child should have their own, properly fitted hard hat. It is also our suggestion that each person visiting the fun horse show should be vaccinated against tetanus.

2.I Accept and voluntarily assume the risk inherent in my and /or my child's use of the horse riding facilities. I release Just Horsing Around horse and pony club and the Memel Famers Association property, its instructors, helpers, and grooms and representatives from any duty of care towards me and or/my child and from liability towards any claim that could occur arising from my and/or his/her participation in horse riding or any related activities, or of any loss of or damage to my and/or his/her property (Whether physical, emotional and/or financial).

3.Such horse riding activities will include but not be limited to riding, working with horses on foot or any other activity undertaken by participants in riding lesson.

4.In the event of an accident involving me and/or my child there is no obligation on Just Horsing Around or/and the Memel Famers Association property to secure for me and/or my child medical treatment; however I do hereby authorize Just Horsing Around or the Famers Association act in my and/or his/her best interest, which may include the obtaining of the necessary emergency medical treatment, which shall be for my account. In such event Just Horsing Around will advise the contact person listed here in of the situation at the earliest possible opportunity but is authorised to secure medical treatment without prior consultation.

5.Neither Just Horsing Around or the Famers Association nor the staff or helpers shall be liable for any loss or damage to property brought to the yard, for example money ,cell phones, tack and clothing.

<u>Barrel Race</u>	Barrel racing is a rodeo event that requires the horse and rider to attempt to complete a cloverleaf pattern around barrels, which have been previously set up, in the fastest time possible.
<u>Bending poles</u>	The has poles set up in a straight line. The horse and rider must weave between the poles and down to the end before turning and zigzag back to the starting line to finish their run.
<u>Speed Ball</u>	Speed Ball Races require the horse and rider to run down to a cone at the other end of the course to drop a ball into the top of the cone just as they make the turn around the cone. The goal is to get the golf ball in the cone without stepping on or knocking over the cone. Once the golf ball has been dropped the rider and horse must run back to the starting line to finish the event.
<u>Exchange Race</u>	First rider starts mounted in saddle at starting line. At signal, first rider races to second rider who is standing behind turning line. After crossing turning line, first rider dismounts and second rider makes an attempt to mount. Second rider must be astride horse before crossing finish line. Riders may assist each other. Disqualification for not crossing turning line, losing contact with horse.
<u>Pair Rope</u>	Partners are mounted at starting line holding a 4-inch by 5-foot rope between them. At signal, they race around a 30-gallon barrel centered on turning line, making a left turn, and race across finish line. Riders will be disqualified for not making a left turn or letting loose of rope at any time before both horses cross the finish line.
<u>Western Jumping</u>	A pole 4m in length is placed 60 feet from the start/finish line. Six poles centered in lane. Last pole placed on the turning line with remaining poles set 21 feet apart toward start/finish line. At signal, contestant races to and crosses jump, weaves poles through and back, crosses jump and races to finish line. Horse must cross jump with all four feet.
