

# **New Jersey-Based Resources for Immigrants Suffering From ICE Attacks**

Below you can find New Jersey-based resources to provide immigrant communities assistance in the face of an increase in immigration enforcement.

## **What is immigration enforcement?**

- When immigration agents, typically Immigration and Customs Enforcement or “ICE,” are actively making arrests, speaking to community members, or conducting surveillance.

## **What is an immigration or ICE arrest?**

- When immigration agents arrest a community member.

## **What is an immigration or ICE raid?**

- When ICE agents make more than one arrest, typically at a home raid, workplace raid, or during a car stop.
