### *A Bit About Santa Clara County...*

#### **Population of 1.918 Million (2015) | 1,304 square miles**

Santa Clara County's population of nearly 1.8 million is one of the largest in the state, following Los Angeles, San Diego and Orange Counties, and the largest of the nine Bay Area counties. Its population constitutes about one fourth of the Bay Area's total population. There are 15 cities ranging from Palo Alto in the north, to Gilroy in the south

San Jose is the largest city in the County, with a population of nearly one million, and is the administrative site of County Government. A significant portion of the county's land area is unincorporated ranch and farmland. Nearly 92% of the population lives in cities.
