Trans Masculine and interested in PrEP?

PrEP stands for Pre-Exposure Prophylaxis. PrEP is an HIV prevention strategy where HIV negative people take medication before sex or sharing needles when they may be exposed to HIV to reduce their risk of becoming infected. The medication works to prevent HIV from establishing infection inside the body. If you think you might want to start PrEP, talk to your health care provider. If you and your provider agree that PrEP is right for you, you will have to take an HIV test and do other baseline labs. You may also need a physical examination. If you start taking PrEP, you can expect to see your provider every 3 months for follow-up appointments.
