

3D Fall Inspired Leaves

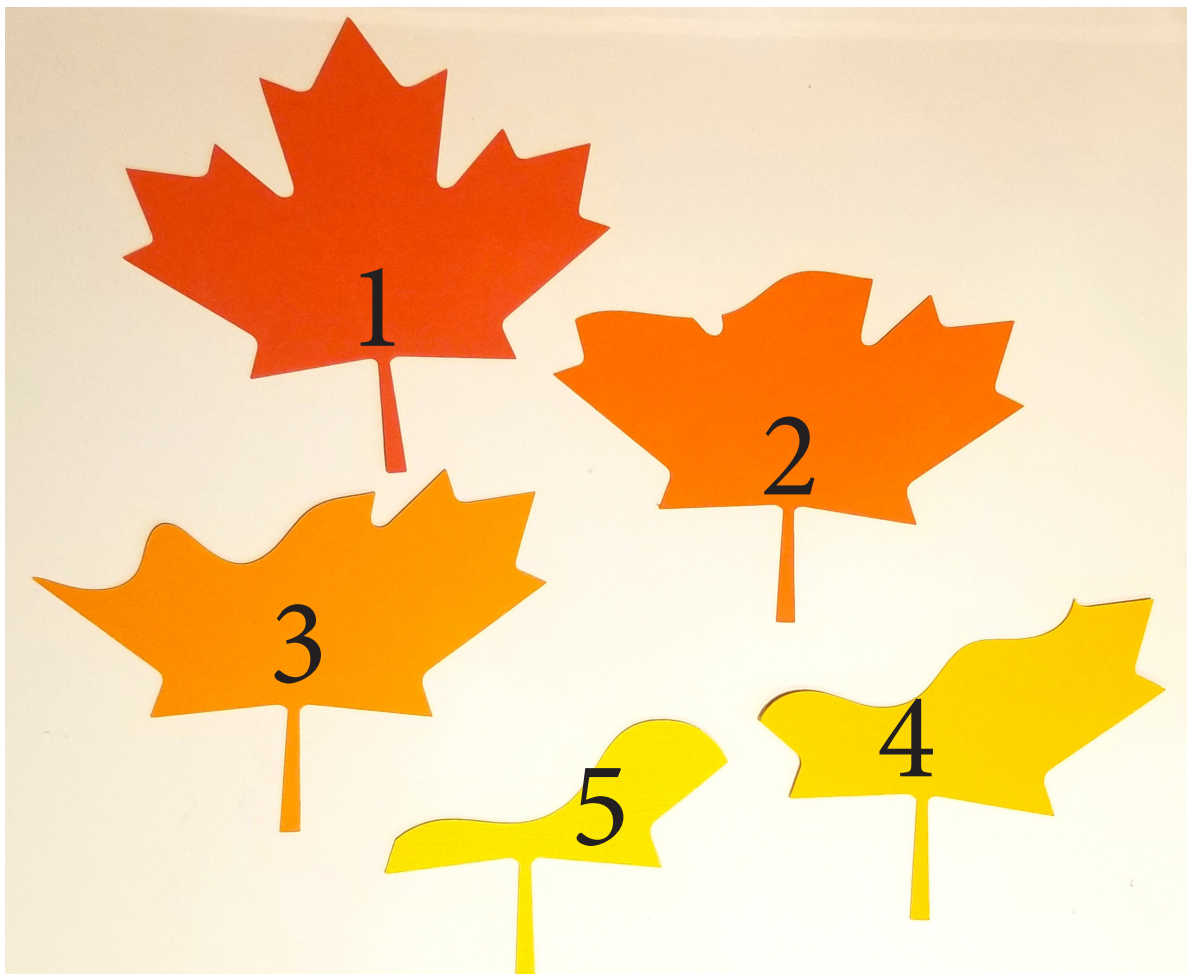


Materials

- Card stock in 5 different colors (for ombre use 5 different shades of one color)
- Cricut cutting machine or scissors
- Adhesive foam tabs (this is what adds dimensions to the leaves.)
- Maple leaf template if using scissors

Instructions

1. Figure out how you want your leaf color to fade. The one in the pic below is from dark (back layer) to light (front layer). You can do the opposite or whatever is to your liking!



2. If using scissors, trace the shapes onto the pieces of cardstocks. Cut the 5 pieces out and put in order from biggest (leaf labeled 1) to smallest (leaf labeled 5).

If using Cricut, open your design space, click new project, and hit images in the menu on the left. Type #MD039EB2 into the search box or Canada Day Maple Leaf. Click the Insert Image button at the bottom of the screen. You can alter the size of the leaves to your liking. When you're ready, click make it.

3. Once the pieces are cut, lay piece 1 out and place piece 2 over it to ensure they are lined up correctly. Flip piece 2 over to apply the pieces of foam tape sporadically. Make sure the tape doesn't hang over the edges. Cut a small piece to fit at the base of the stem. Flip piece 2 back over and align onto piece one (I used the base of stem to align the rest of the leaf). Press lightly to make sure the leaf shape is sticking to the bottom leaf.



4. Repeat step 3 for the rest of the leaf shapes until it is completed. That's it!
