


About Preety



ALBUMS RELEASED

Preety burst into the Indian pop scene with her song "Damadam Mast Kalandar" from the album "Jalwa II" released by Times Music in 2001. The music video featured Preety & it was shot in the magnificant 'Qutub Shahi Tombs' in Hyderabad. The song was a great hit & still plays on all radio channels.

She then released her Solo Debut Indipop Album in 2003 which was produced by Musicurry Records in association with Times Music. The video song was the foot-tapping catchy marathi flavoured "Saangu Nakaa". She featured in the music video & the song was nominated in the category of BEST NEW NON-FILM TALENT for IMMIES MTV MUSIC AWARDS' 2003.

She presented different flavours in her music album "Tumhi Toh Ho" released by M&M Music in 2007, in the presence of legendary Ustad Sultan Khan Saheb, the great vocalist Sukhwinder & Abhijit & the vibrant percussionist Shivamani. Singing Graphy


