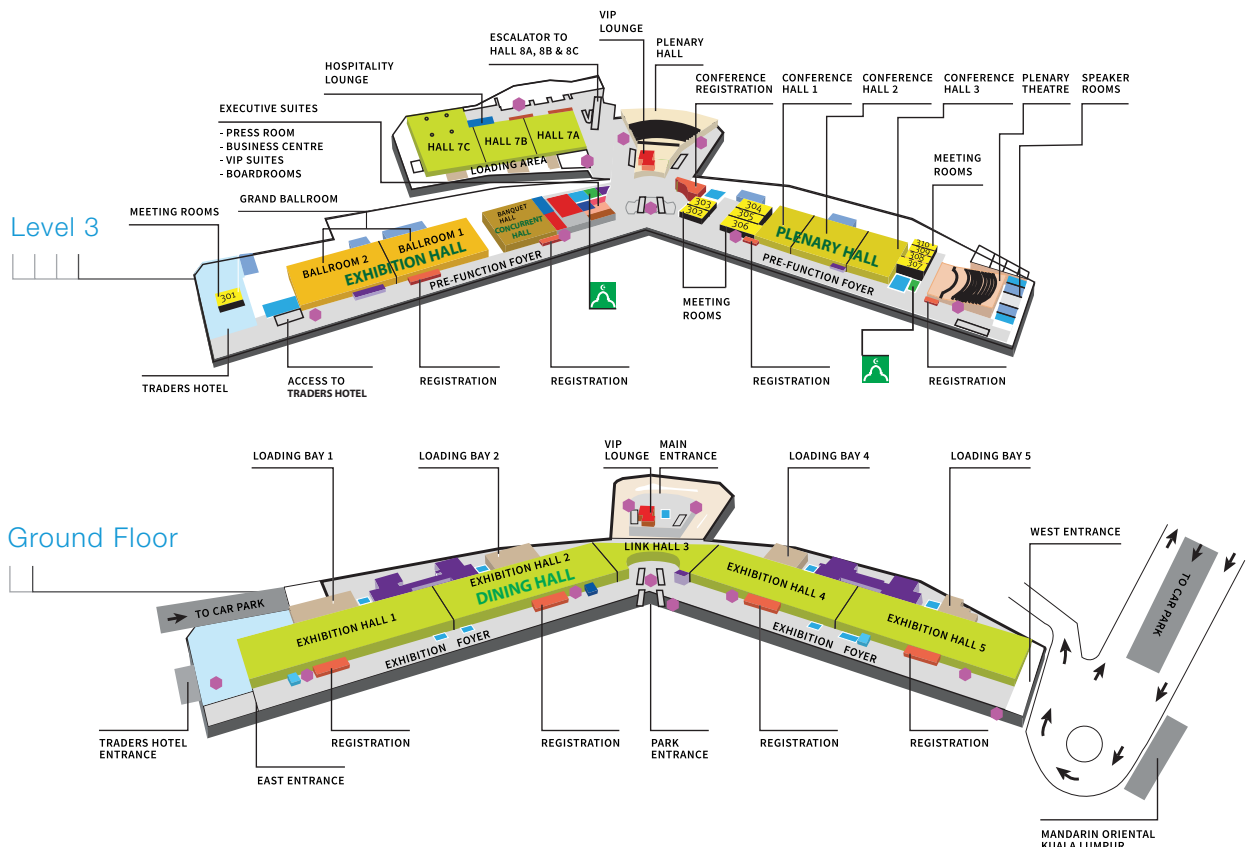

1. PAYMENTS

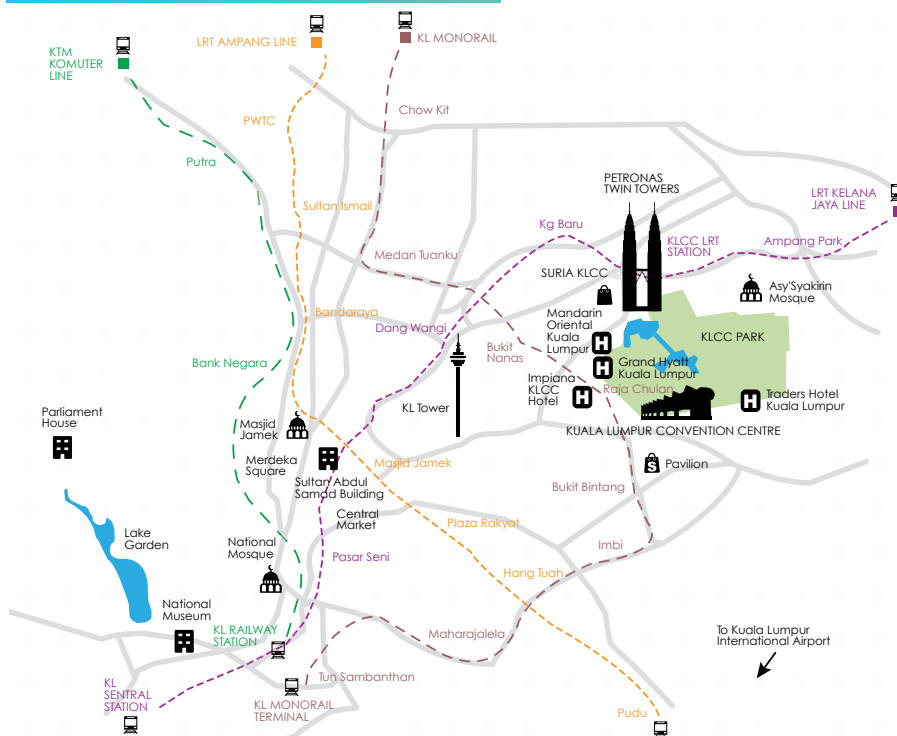
