

## 2018 Year in Review

Art with a Heart in Healthcare provides personalized fine art experiences that enhance the healing process for patients and their families.

Art with a Heart in Healthcare is a 501 (c)3 non-profit organization dedicated exclusively to arts and healing. Since our founding in 2001 by cousins Lori Guadagno and Lisa Ullmann, we have served more than 80,000 patients and their families in Jacksonville, Florida at various healthcare facilities including Wolfson Children's Hospital, Nemours Children's Specialty Clinic, The Mayo Clinic, and St. Vincent's Healthcare, Riverside.

Our emphasis on patient-centered creative expression helps humanize the high-tech atmosphere of clinical environments.

Patients, families, and clinicians we work with report that our services help diminish fear and relieve pain while empowering the patient who can sometimes find themselves in a powerless situation.


