



Signature Detail:

Exterior Service:

- Tires & Wheel soaked with cleaner specifically formulated to remove all the brake dust, road grime & debris
- Using a variety of brushes, we scrubbed the side walls of your tires, as well as the interior barrels of each wheel, the wheel faces & lug nuts followed by a thorough rinse of the tire & wheel
- We then use a degreaser to spray on each fender well and scrub with our specific fender well brush to remove the dirt and debris from the fender well, and the suspension parts in the fender well area & rinse clean.
- We then move on to your door jambs, by gently rinsing them with a very low pressure, yet high volume of water. We follow the rinse by hand washing and brushing out all the cracks and tight spots using a variety of cleansers (soaps and gentle degreasers specifically for paint & plastic surfaces). We will rinse each area and wipe dry.
- We give your entire vehicle a thorough pre-rinse prior to hand washing the exterior. We do this to remove any debris that could cause scratches & marring to the paint and glass surfaces.
- We use a “2 bucket wash” to wash your vehicle. Bucket #1 is our clean water rinse bucket, and bucket #2 is our soap bucket.
- We wash starting at the highest point first and wash panel by panel, rinsing our wash pads after each panel is thoroughly washed and rinsed. This ensures we do not have any left-over debris from each panel as we move on.
- We use very soft boars’ hairbrushes to clean your window seals, emblems, & grill area to remove bugs, grit and debris we cannot remove with our microfiber wash pads.
- We give your car a 2-pass rinse cycle with our 1900 psi pressure washer, rinsing out every drop of cleaning agent we have used to remove all the dirt and unwanted spots on the car.
- We then will decontaminate your paint surface using our IronX Fallout remover & a clay bar. Followed by another extensive rinse cycle. After this, we blow dry

your vehicle followed by a wipe down using specialized microfiber drying towels for a streak free finish and a high gloss shine!!!

Your exterior has never been so clean!!!! We're moving on to the interior!

Interior Service:

- We start by removing all the interior contents and placing them in label clear "content bags" and placing them on a table that is specified for your vehicle. This ensures all your personal belongings are safe and placed back into the proper areas when we complete the services.
- We then remove all your floor mats & clean those in a separate area so they can be drying as we continue the service of your interior.
- We then do a "blow-out" of your interior. A blow-out is using compressed air blowers and a vacuum. We start at the rear of your vehicle and blow the seats, panels, carpet, and under your seats, removing all the trash, dirt, and debris. We get in every single spot in the vehicle. We vacuum up as we move forward in the vehicle.
- After the vacuuming is completed, we then use LED lighting to locate any areas that would require special attention (which is covered during your evaluation) and begin the work on those areas immediately.
- Once the special attention areas are address and resolved, we will begin the decontamination of each panel of your vehicle. We hand scrub, using a large variety of special brushes, scrub pads, and tools to remove germs, dirt, food, soils and other unwanted things located inside your vehicle. All our cleansers are safe for you and our environment and are also antibacterial.
- We clean out all your air vents, consoles, door panels, storage compartments, truck area, spare tire compartment, under every seat, dash, cup holders, window seals, door jamb seals etc.
- We will then treat your leather seats with our leather conditioner, and bring back the color, softness and that wonderful smell of brand-new leather, followed by an optional leather protection treatment (please ask your detail tech about this). If you choose not to protect your seats with our 1-year protection, your seats still leave with a level of protection you will not find at your store.
- We will then treat all your interior panels with Perl by CarPro to bring back that subtle yet beautiful shine that you seen when it was brand new.
- We do a final vacuum to remove the small amount of debris that is blown out during the detail, reapply your floor mats, apply a light mist of air freshener and clean all your glass, inside and out.
- We then apply your tire shine, and treat all exterior plastics to bring that deep, rich shine back to your rubber and plastics. We do this last, because all our products are water-based and would be removed during the drying process that takes places while

we're detailing the car. This ensures you get the best affect possible from all the treatments your vehicle received.

- Once your vehicle is considered complete by our trained technicians, a 100-point inspection sheet is completed for your vehicle by our quality control department. We do this to ensure nothing has been over-looked or missed. We address any issues found during this inspection and all parties sign-off on the inspection sheet. This sheet is always available to our clients.
- We will contact our client to let them know their vehicle is completed and ready for pick-up or delivery.

Your vehicle has now been cleaned top to bottom, and front to back using only the best products on the market, by highly trained detail technicians.
