About the Workshops

Putting People in the Lead, Big Lottery

Jenny Fish, Local Funding Officer for the Big Lottery Fund will provide an update on the Fund's future priorities to 2021. This interactive session will allow groups to understand what the Fund are planning in terms of their future small and large funding programmes.

Talbot Village Trust

The Talbot Village Trust is one of the area's leading benefactors, supporting charitable causes and local community groups in Christchurch, Bournemouth, Poole, East Dorset and the Isle of Purbeck. In the past couple of years it has donated nearly £2million. This is your opportunity to meet Darryl Tidd, Director of the trust and find out more about the trust and the projects it supports.

Crowdfunding

Crowdfunding is a way of raising money, awareness and support for your project, from the people around you. This workshop, from Crowdfunder UK, will explain how you can make crowdfunding work for your project idea and provide practical tips to get the most out of your campaign. There will also be an opportunity to find out about Crowdfunder Dorset and the funding currently available for youth projects.

Heritage Lottery Fund

The Heritage Lottery Fund offers a range of different grant programmes with grants from £3,000 to over £5million. In assessing applications, HLF take account of the outcomes for heritage, people and communities that projects will achieve. This workshop will look at the different grant schemes available and answer your questions.
